

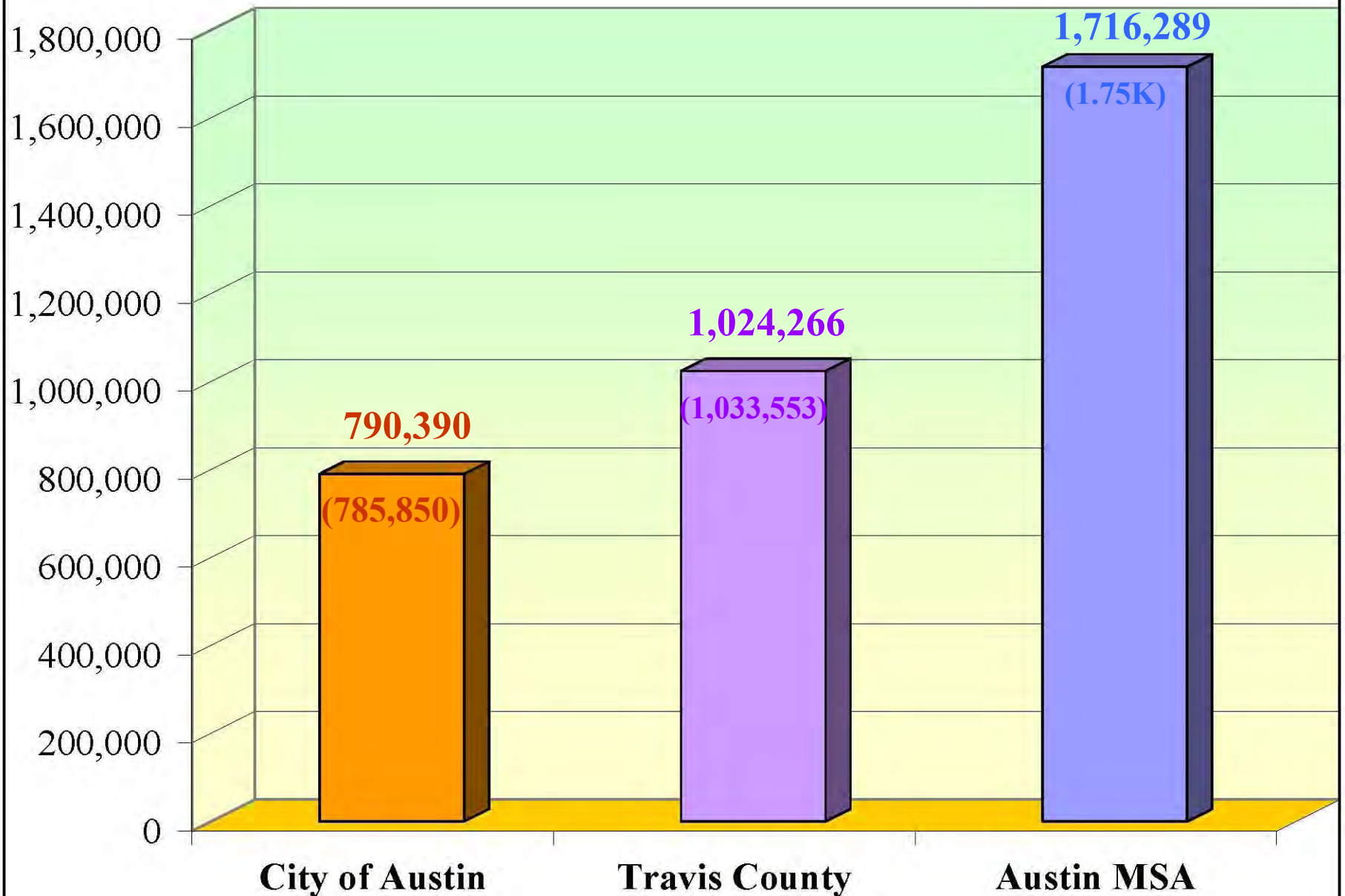

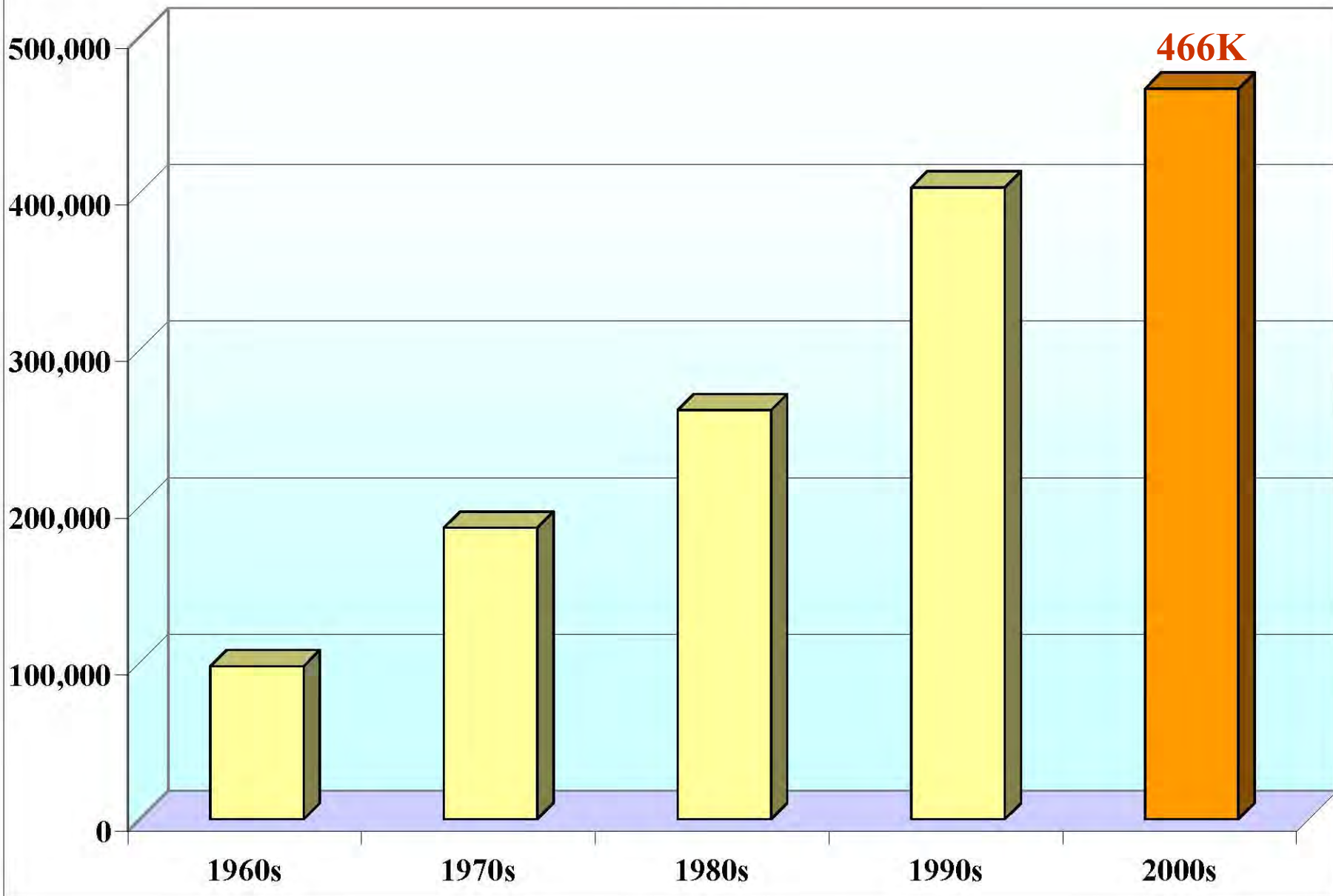




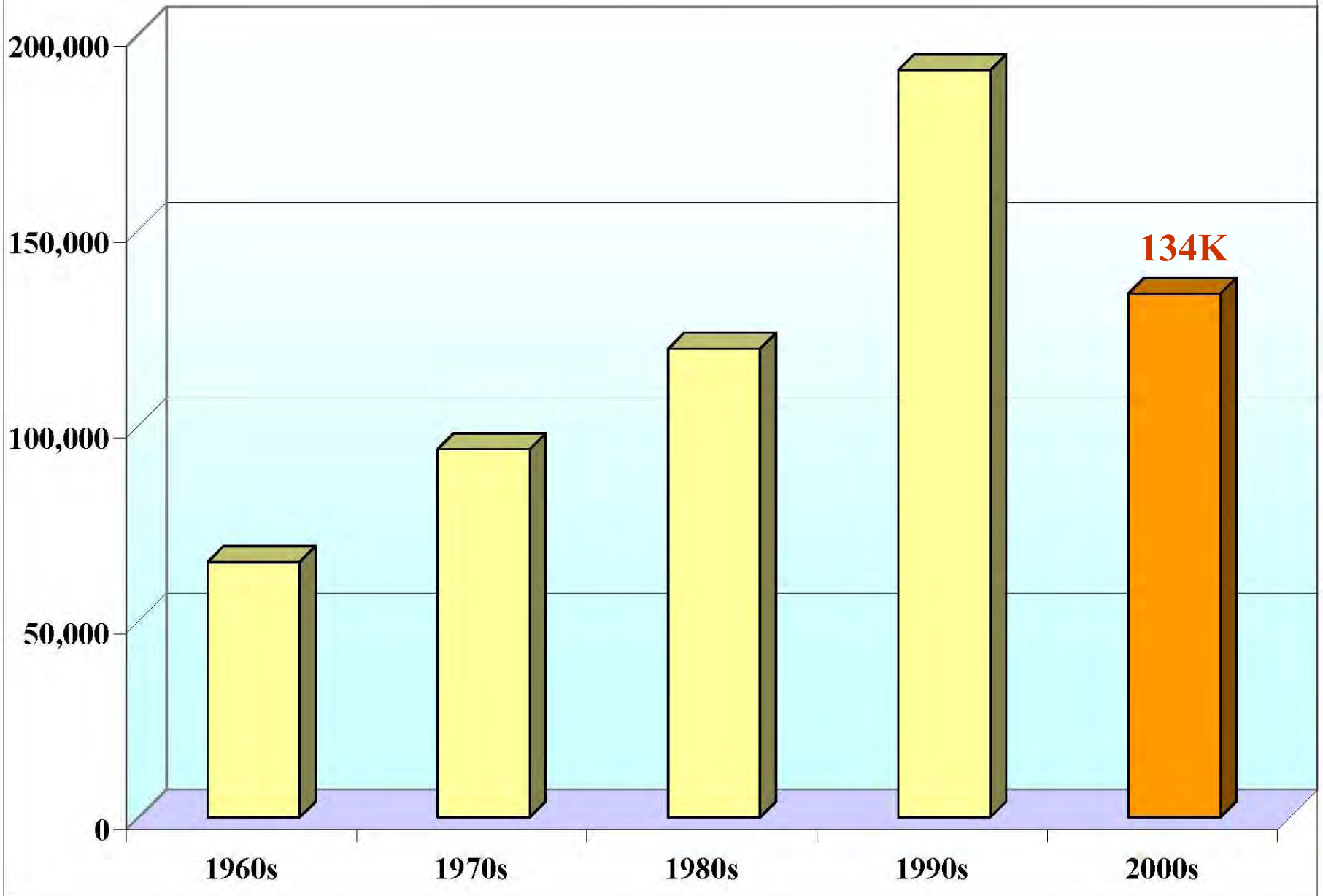
# Final Census 2010 Total Population Figures



# Austin MSA Total Population Growth by Decade: 1960 to 2010

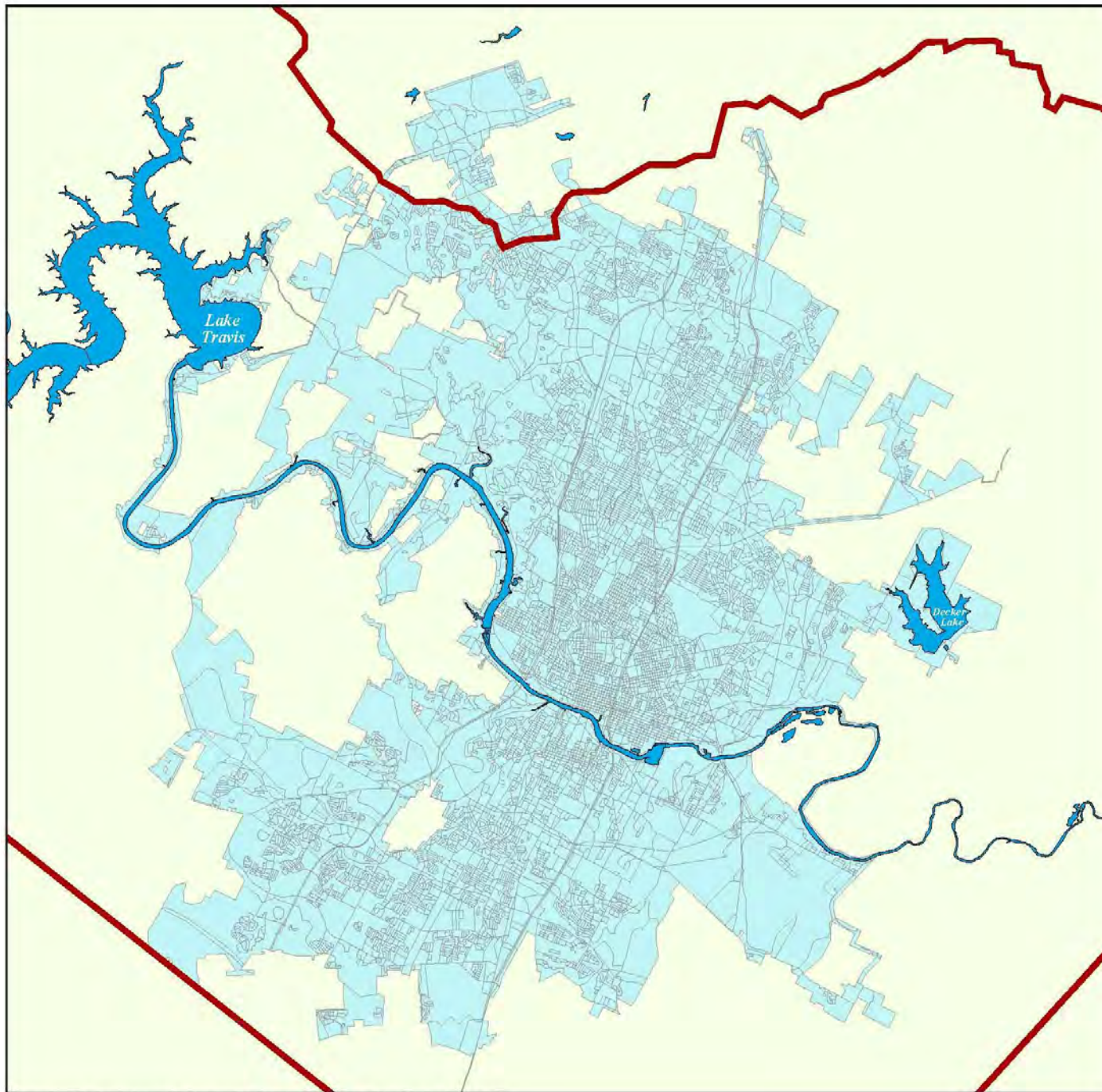


# City of Austin Total Population Growth by Decade: 1960 to 2010





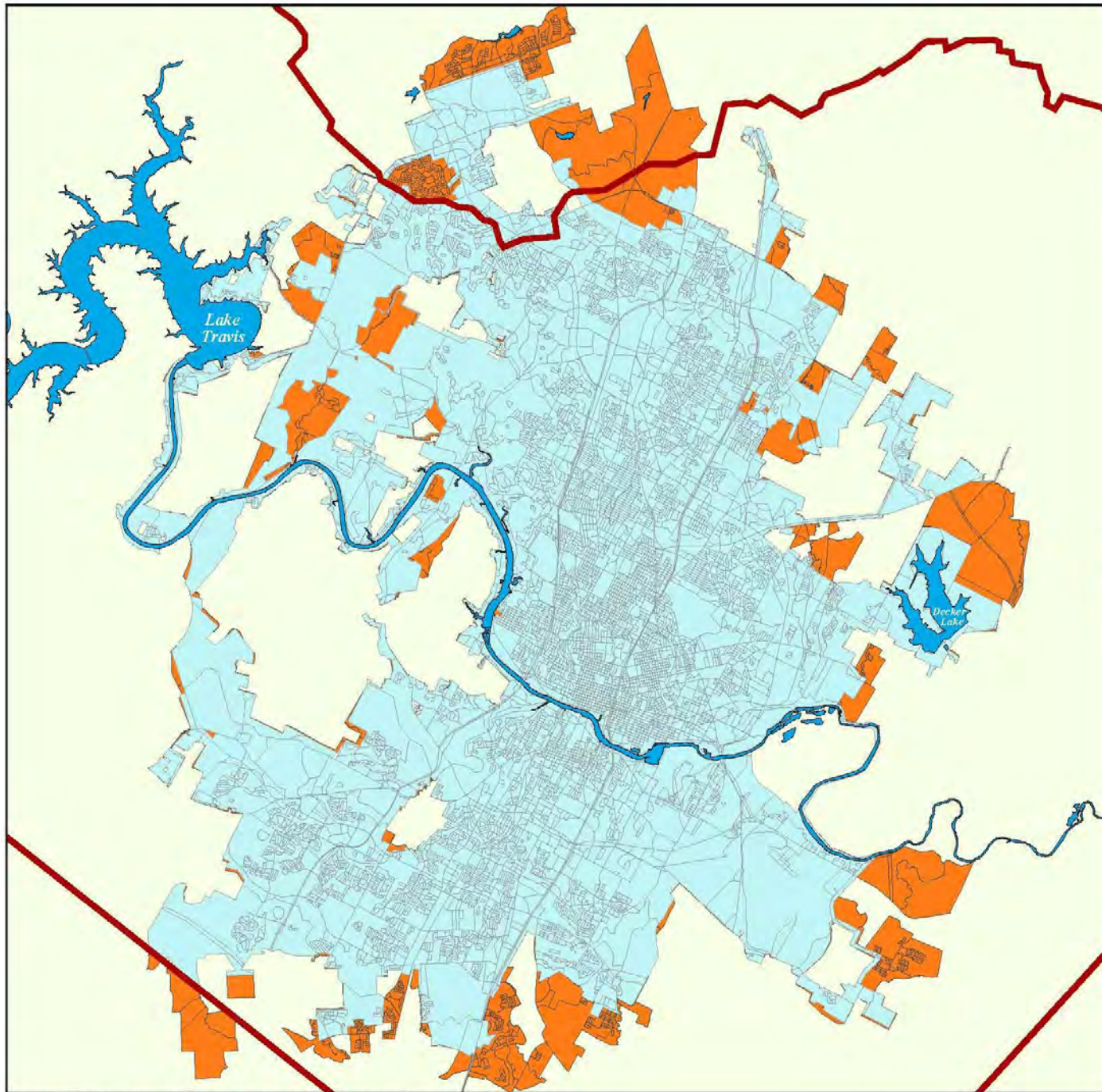
# City of Austin Jurisdictional Change: 2000 to 2010

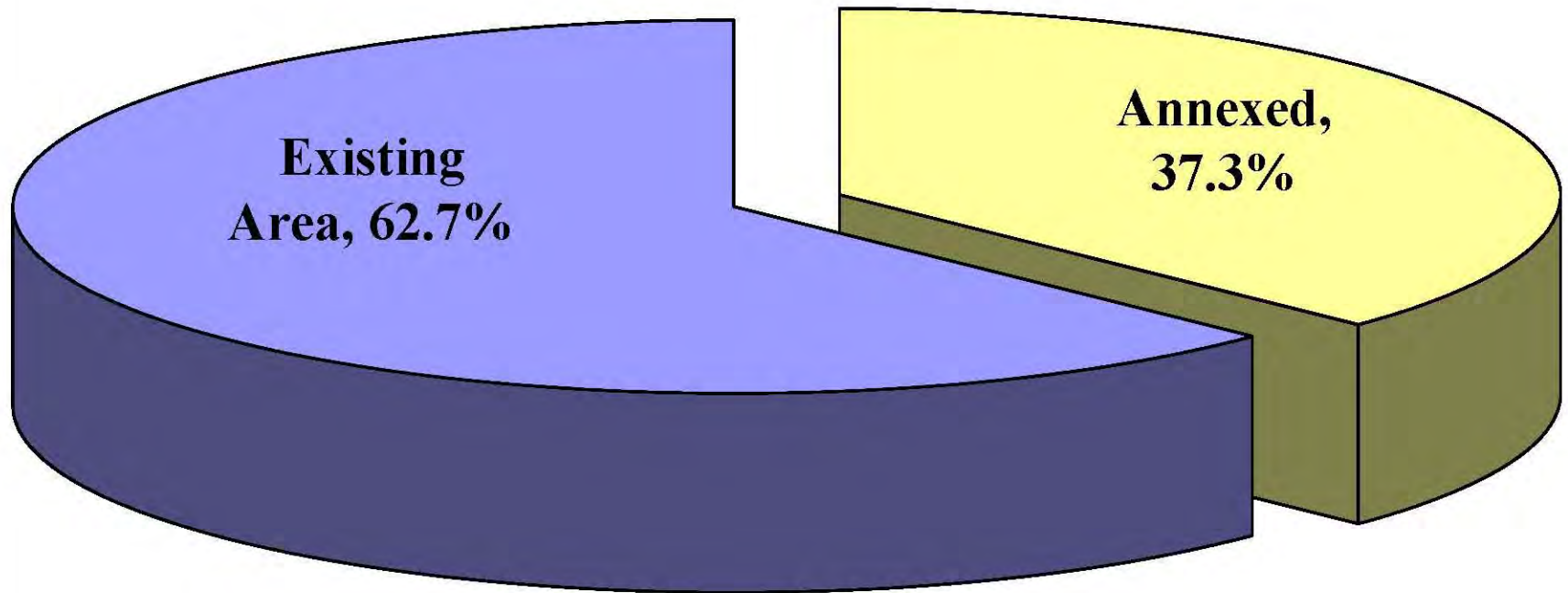

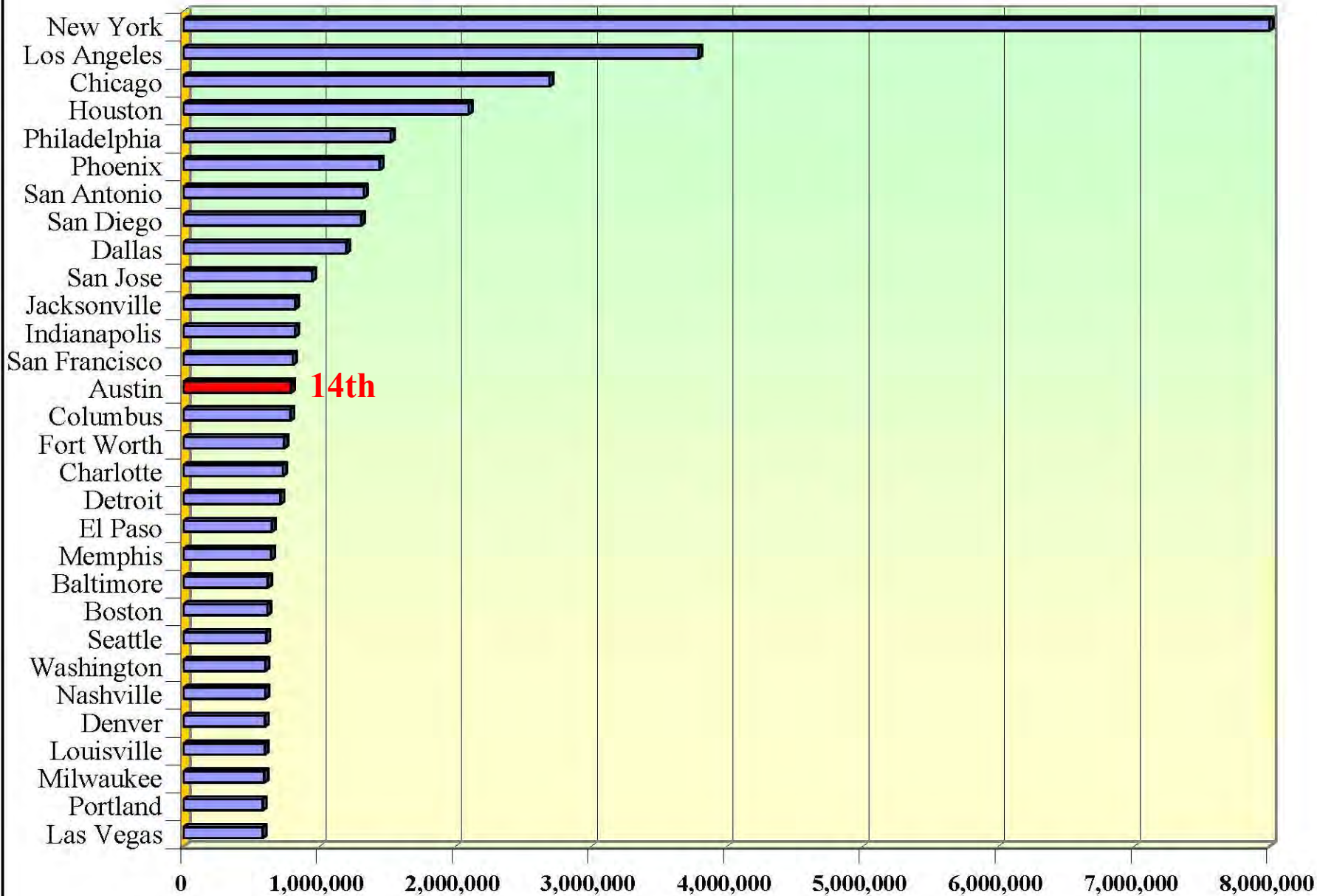

# Source of City of Austin Population Growth (134K+) from 2000 to 2010: Annexation vs. Existing Area

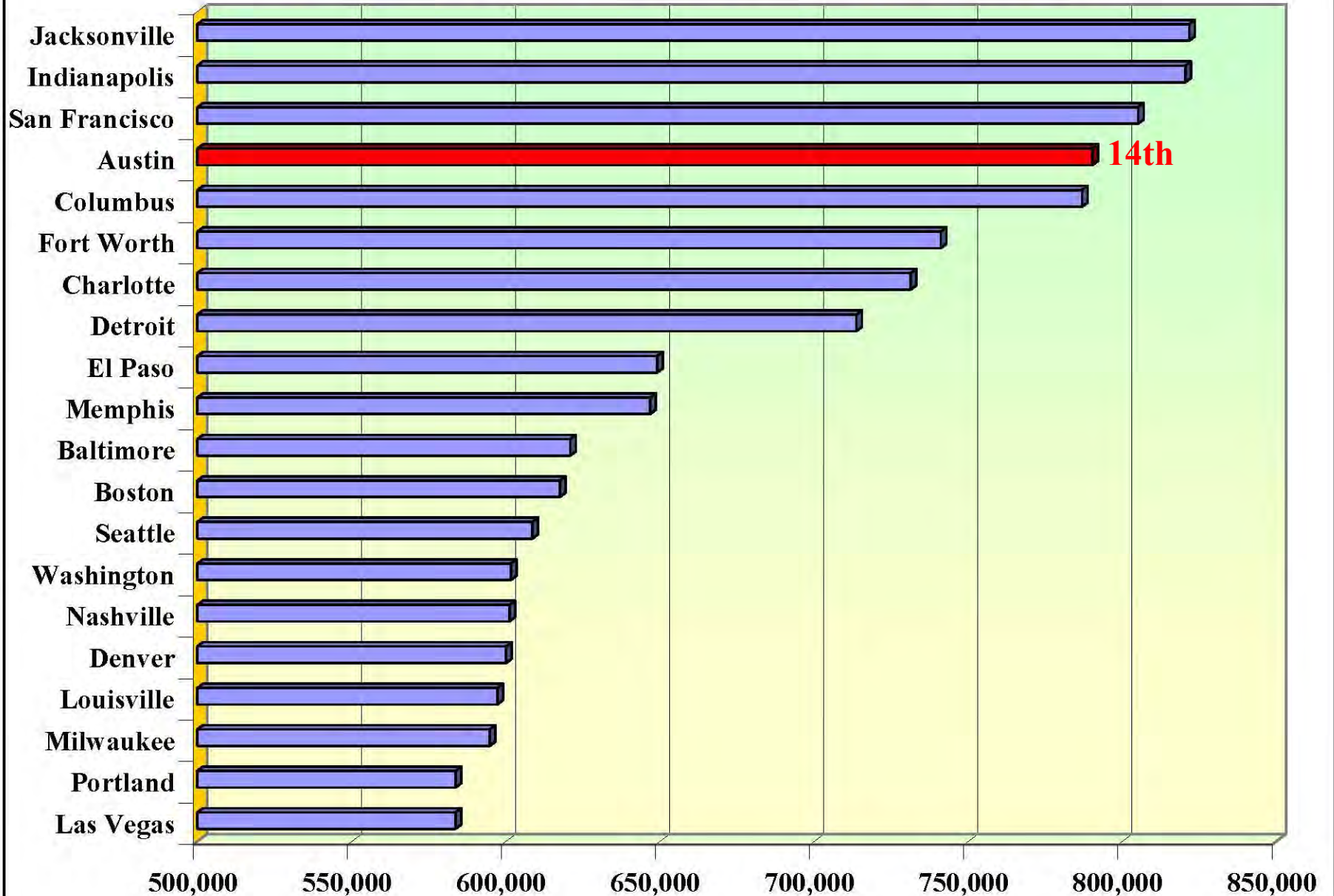




# Top 30 Largest Cities in the US: 2010

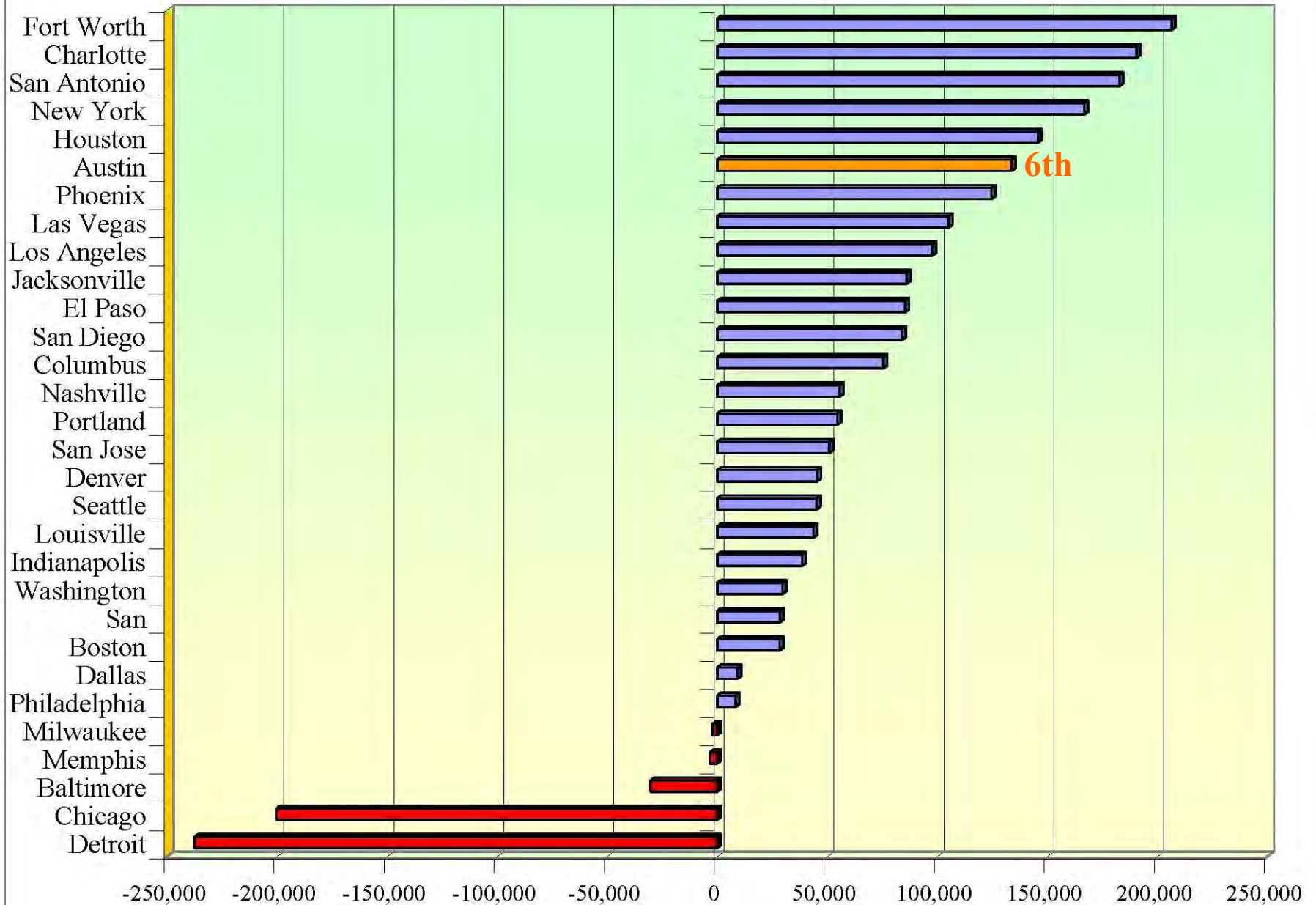


# Largest Cities in US: 2010, 11th to 30th

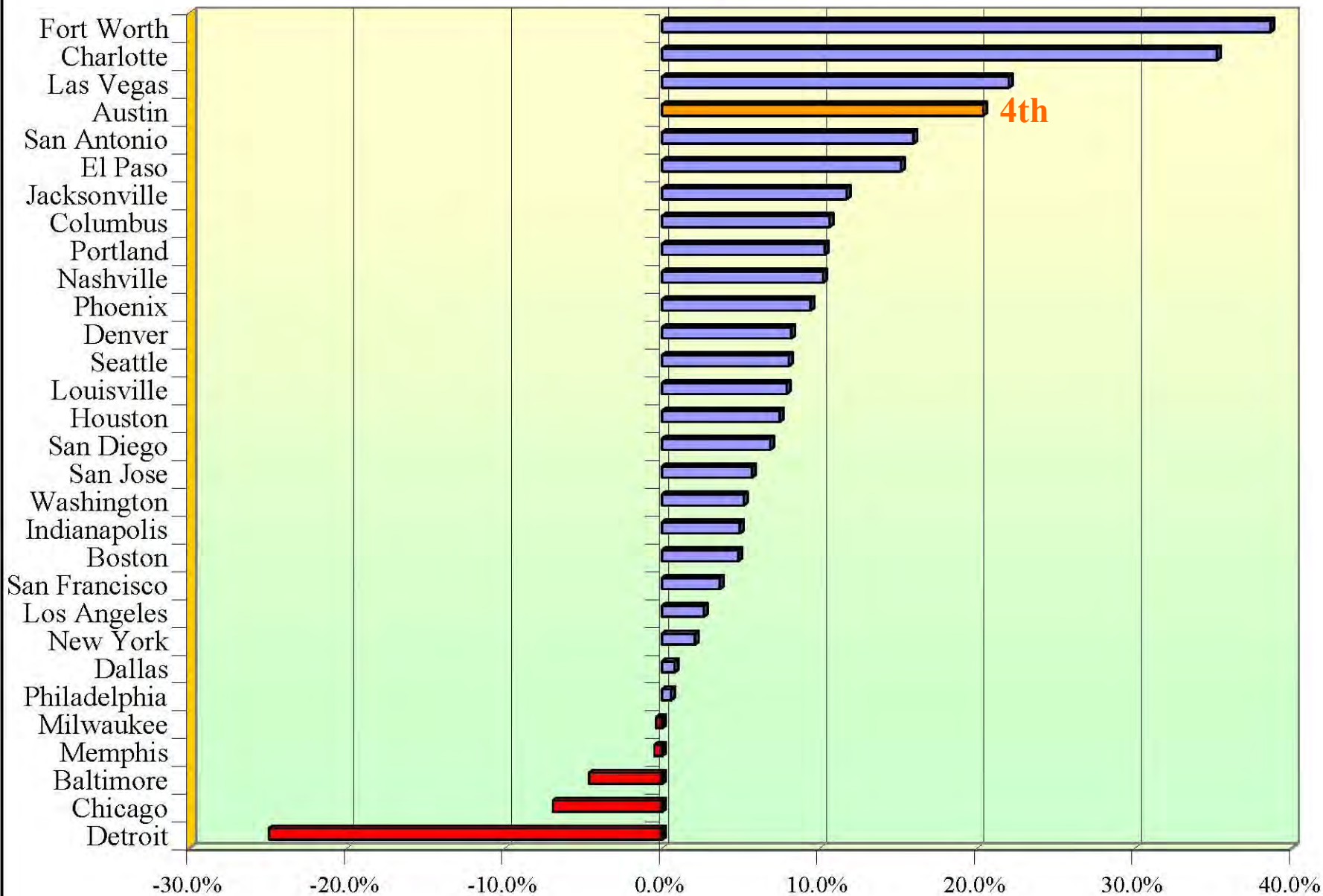




# Growth and Decline, Top 30 US Cities, 2000 to 2010



# Percentage Gain and Loss, Top 30 US Cities, 2000 to 2010





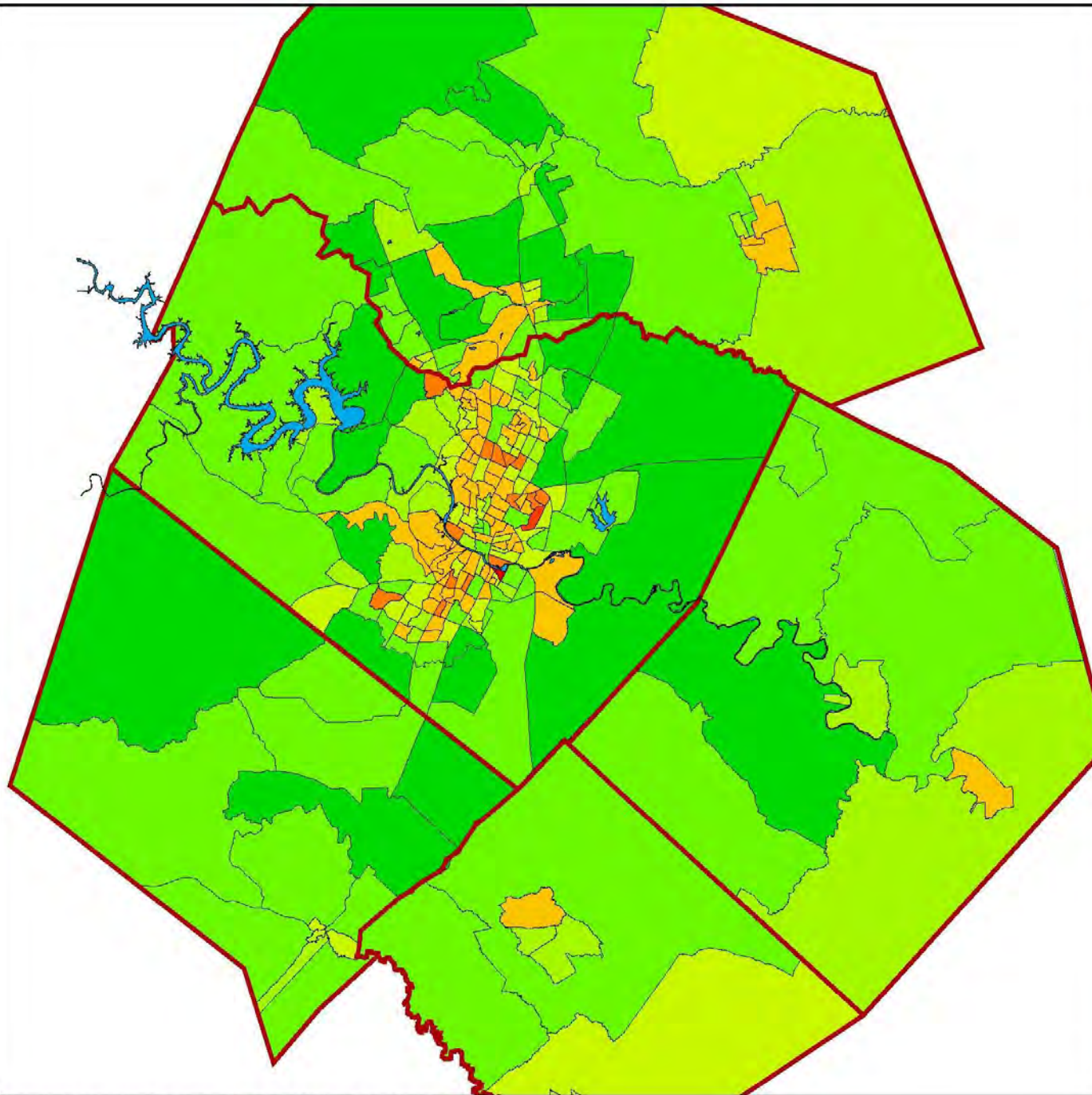
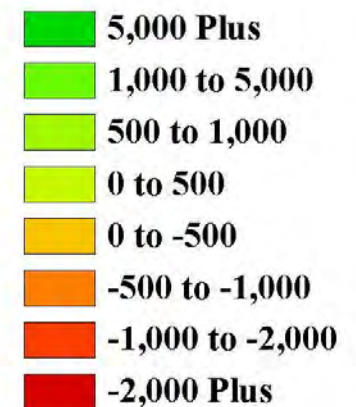

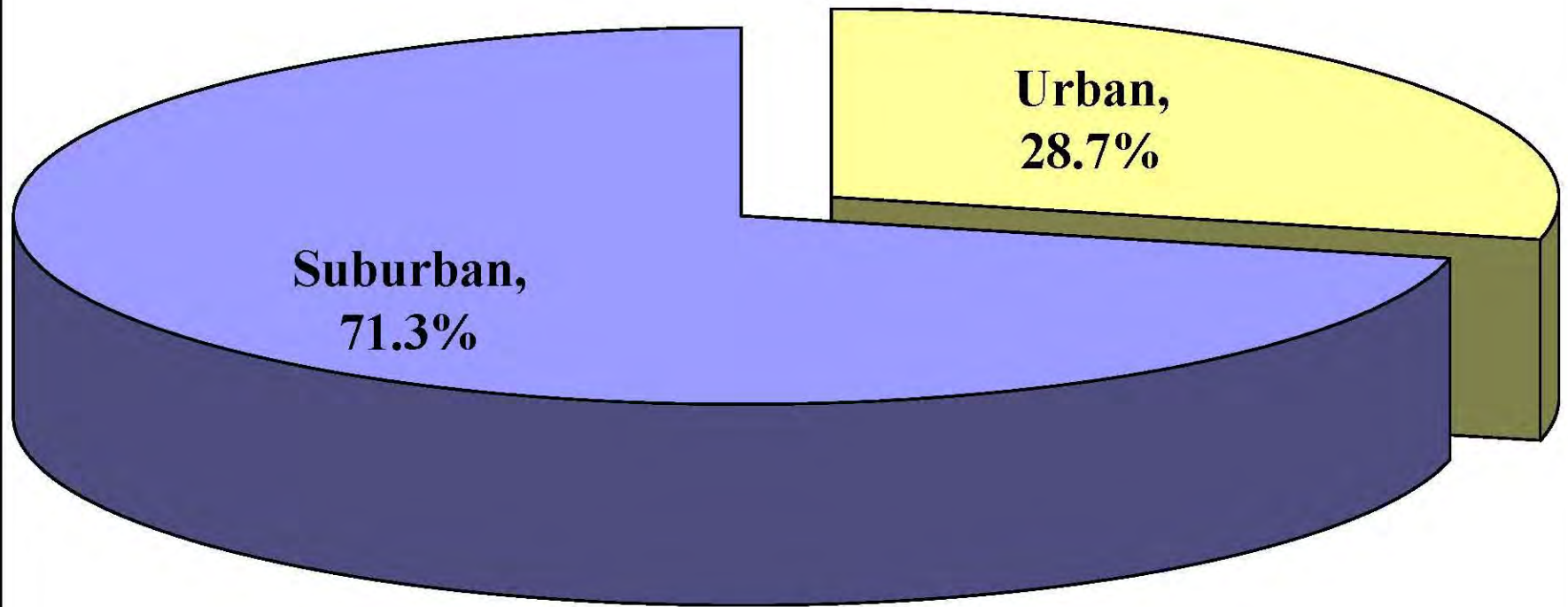

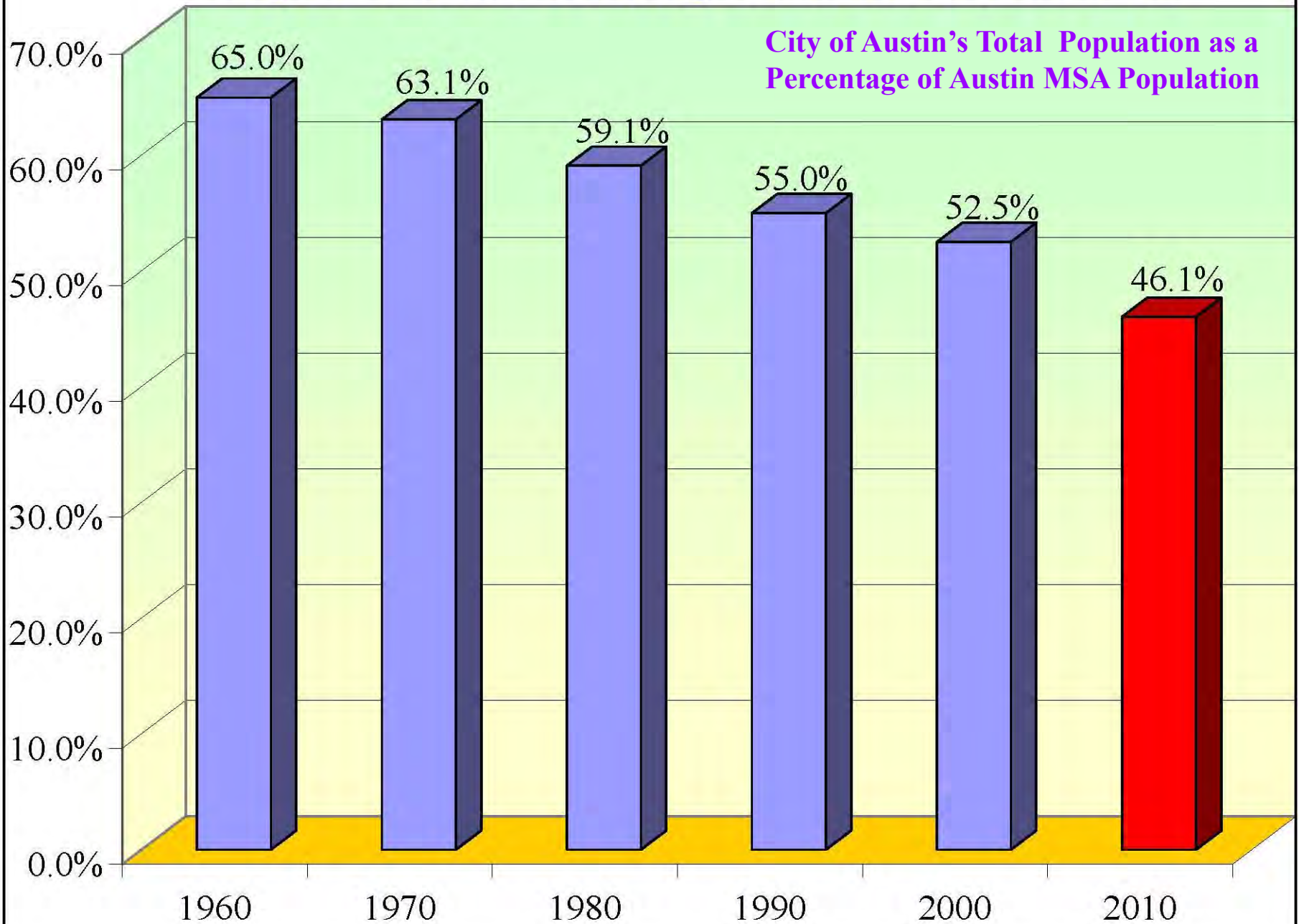

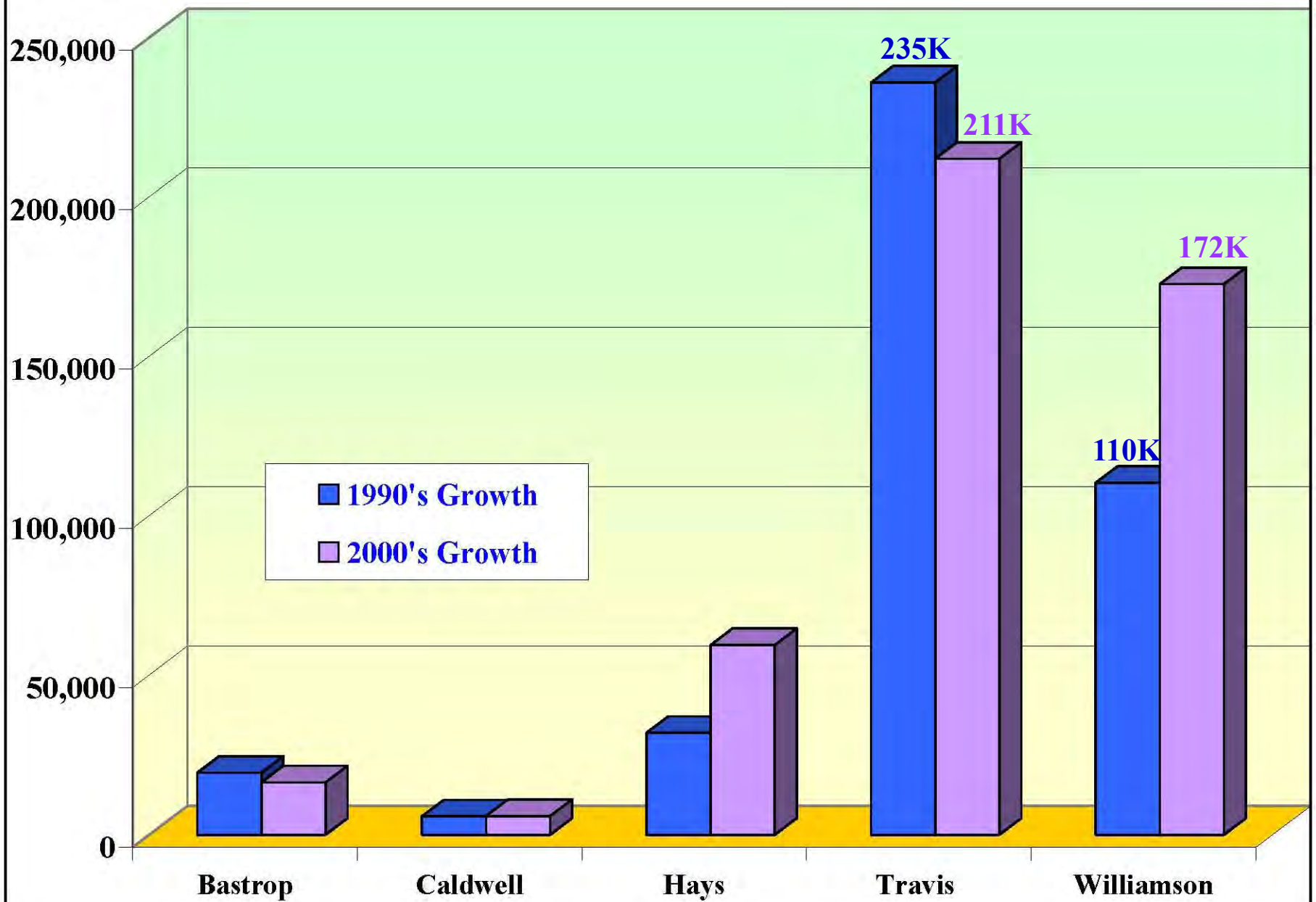


# City of Austin Percentage of MSA: 1960 to 2010

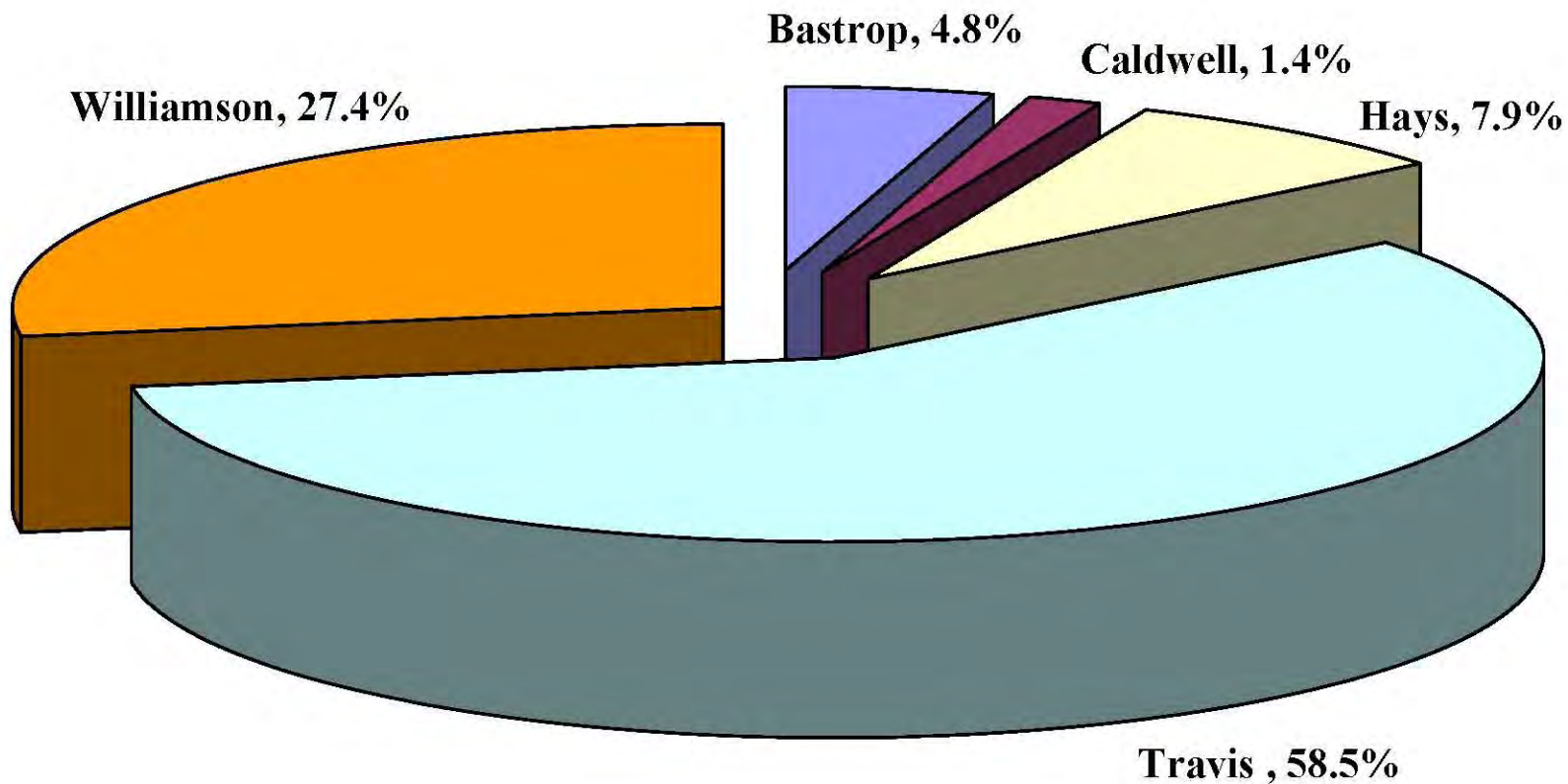




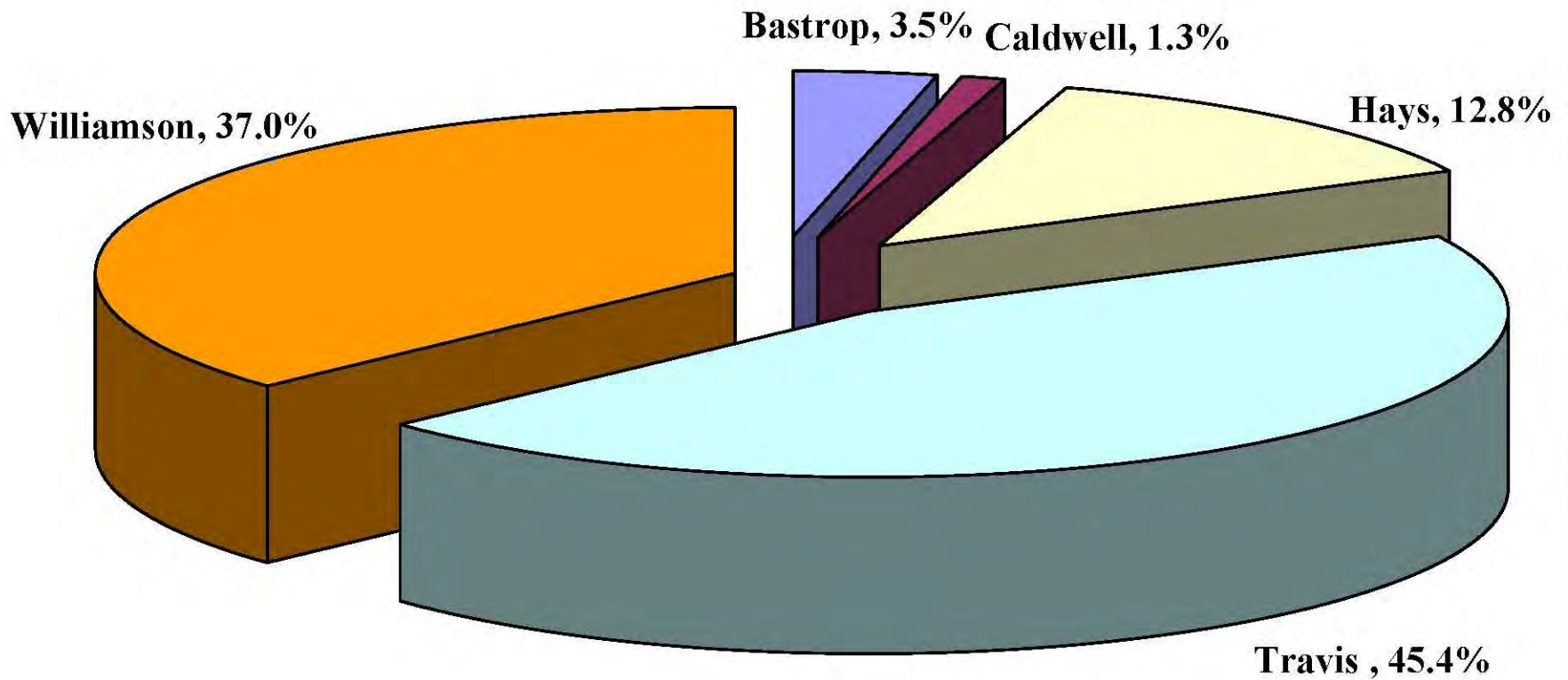

# Share of Total Austin MSA Population Growth 2000 to 2010 by County



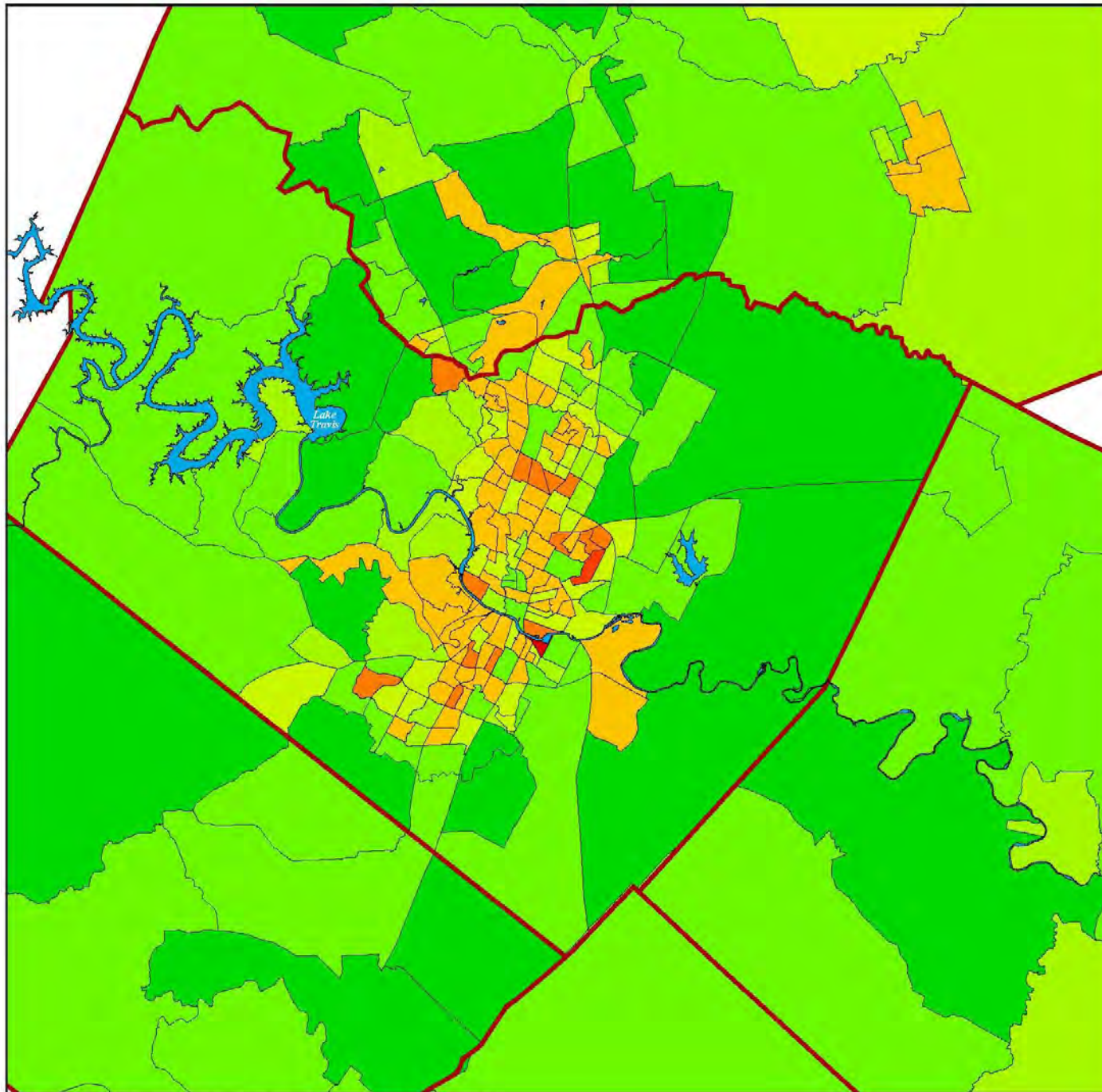
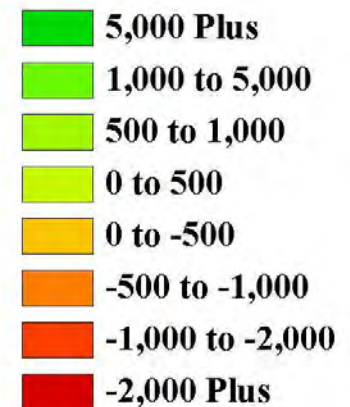

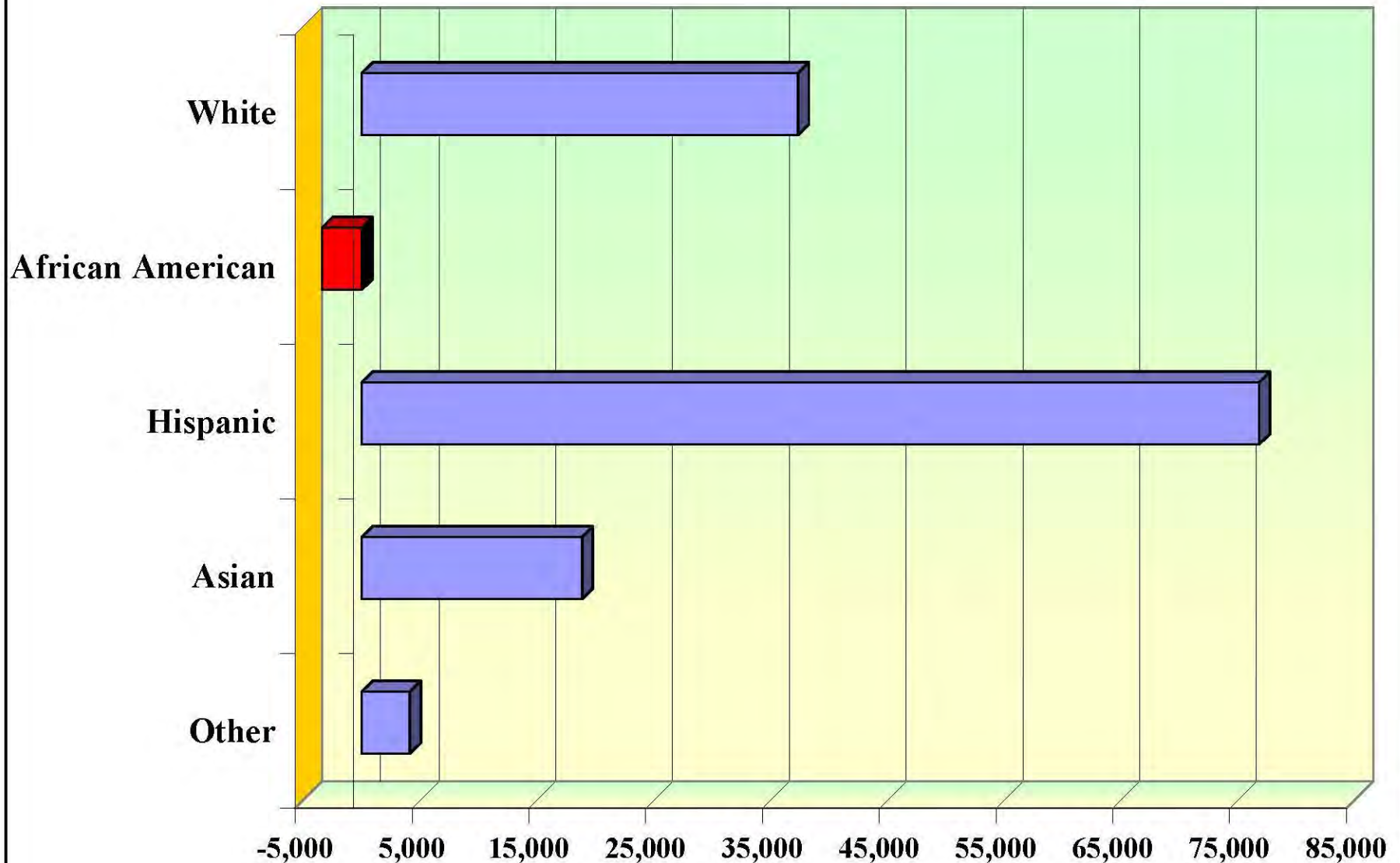

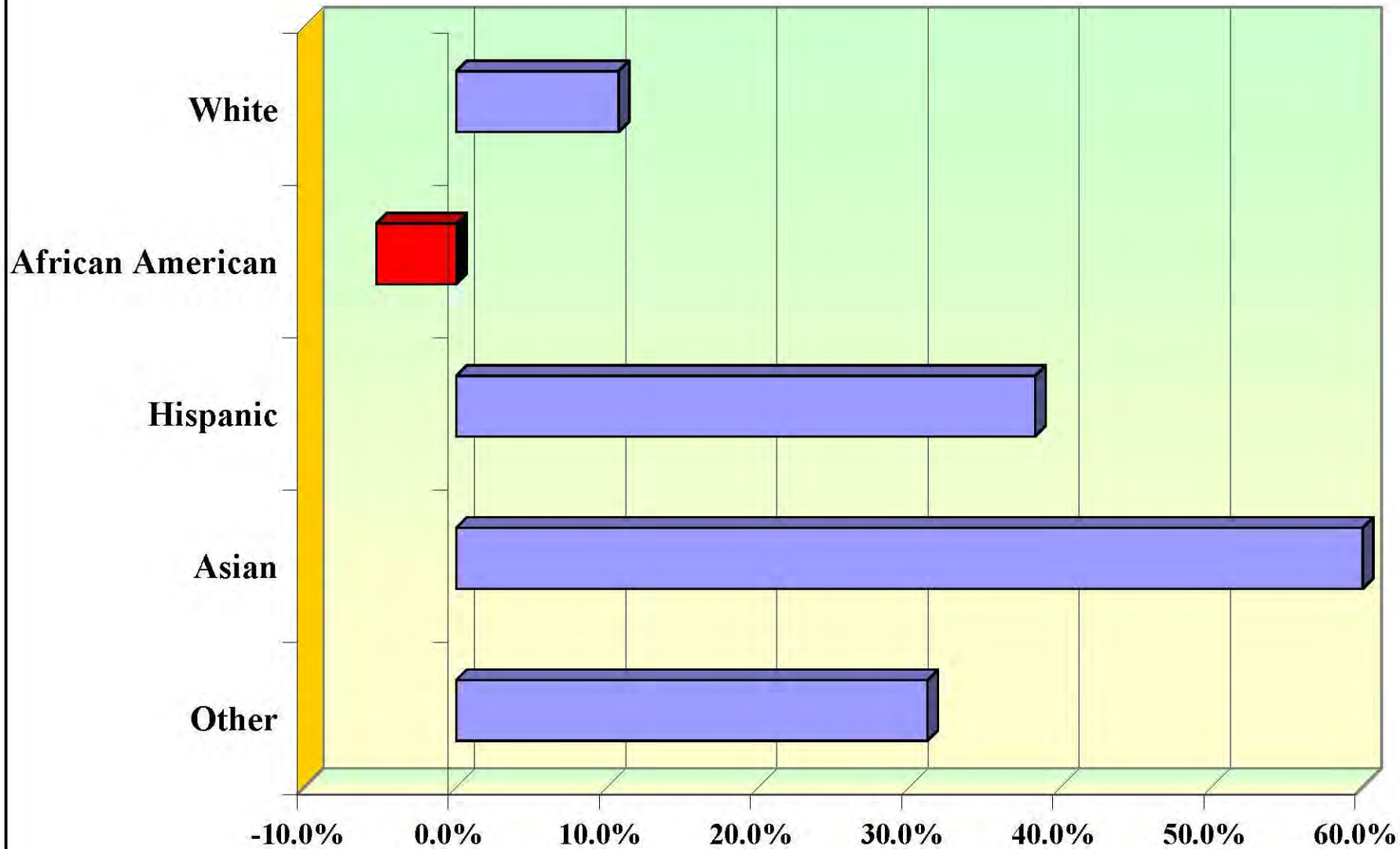

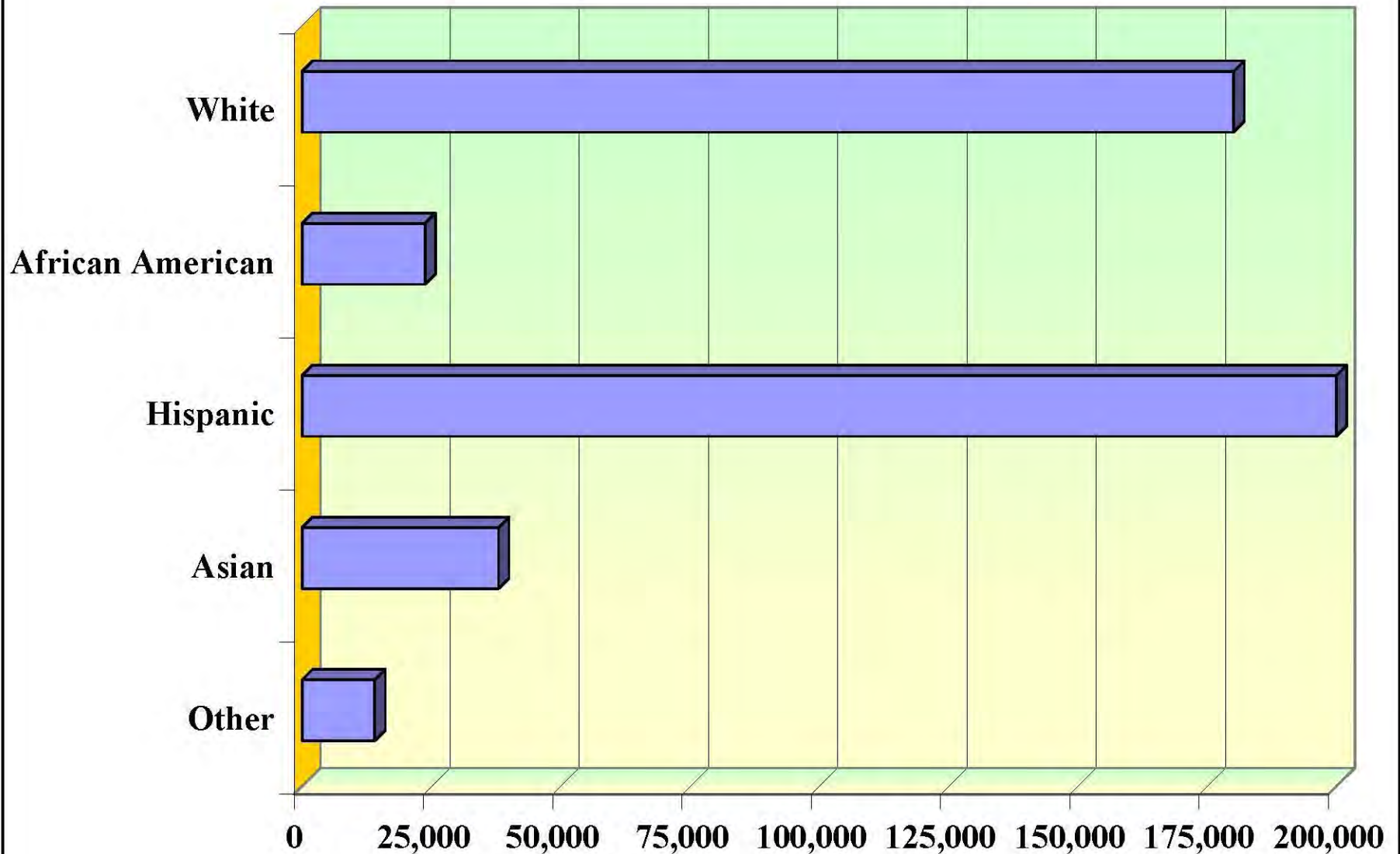




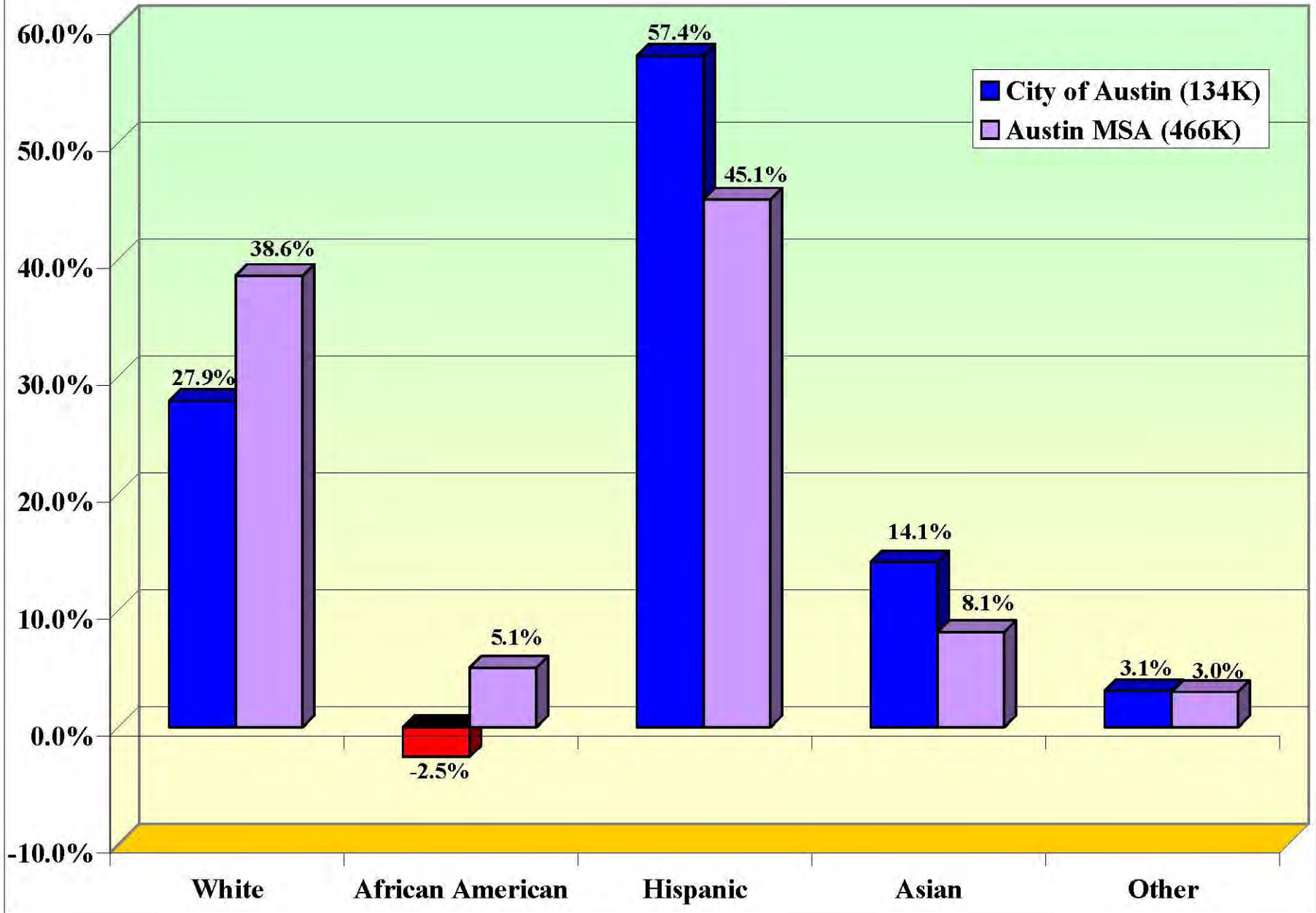
# City of Austin, Percentage Growth by Racial and Ethnic Group, 2000 to 2010

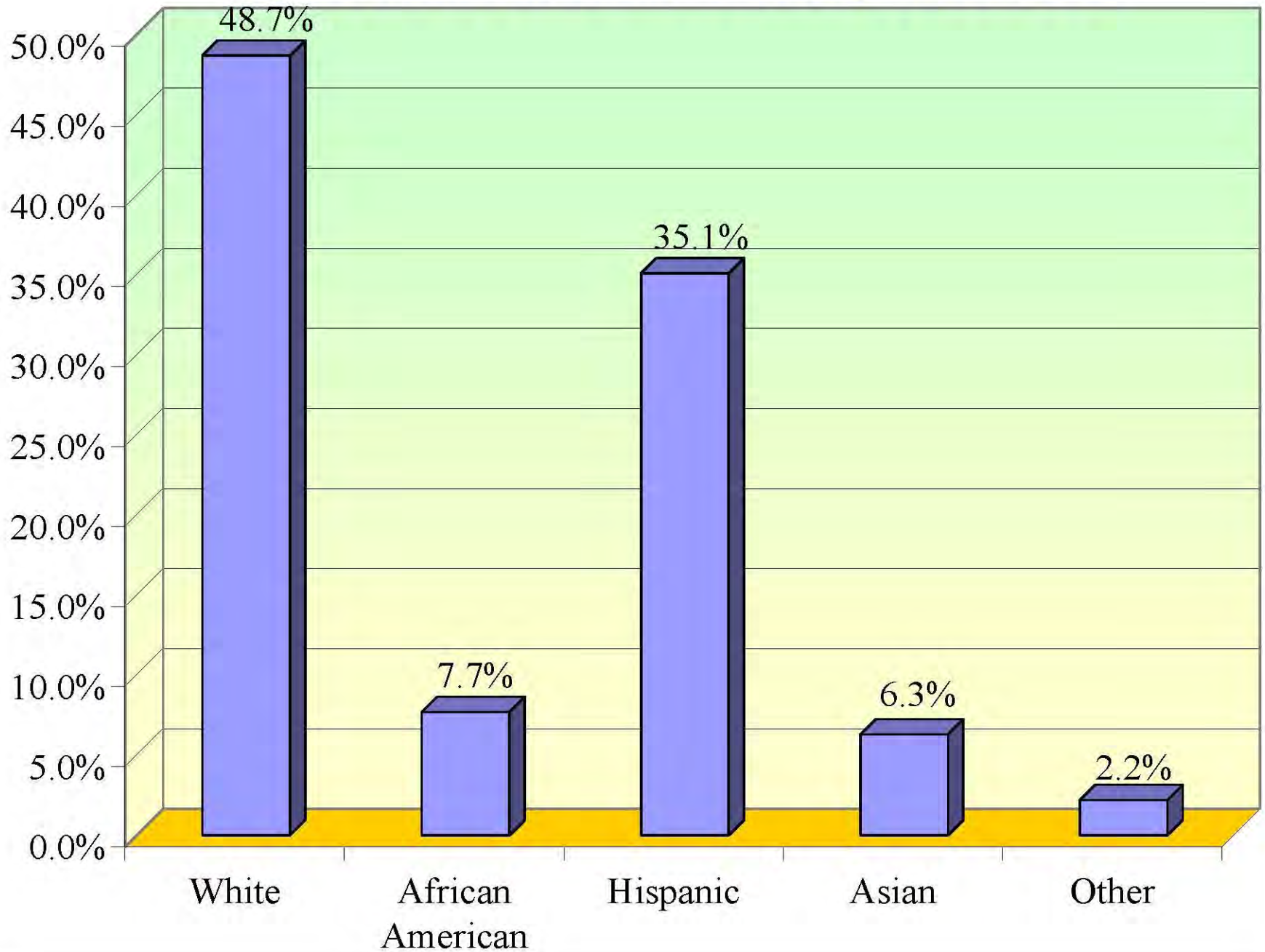


## Share of Total Population Growth from Growth of Racial and Ethnic Groups, City of Austin and the MSA: 2000 to 2010

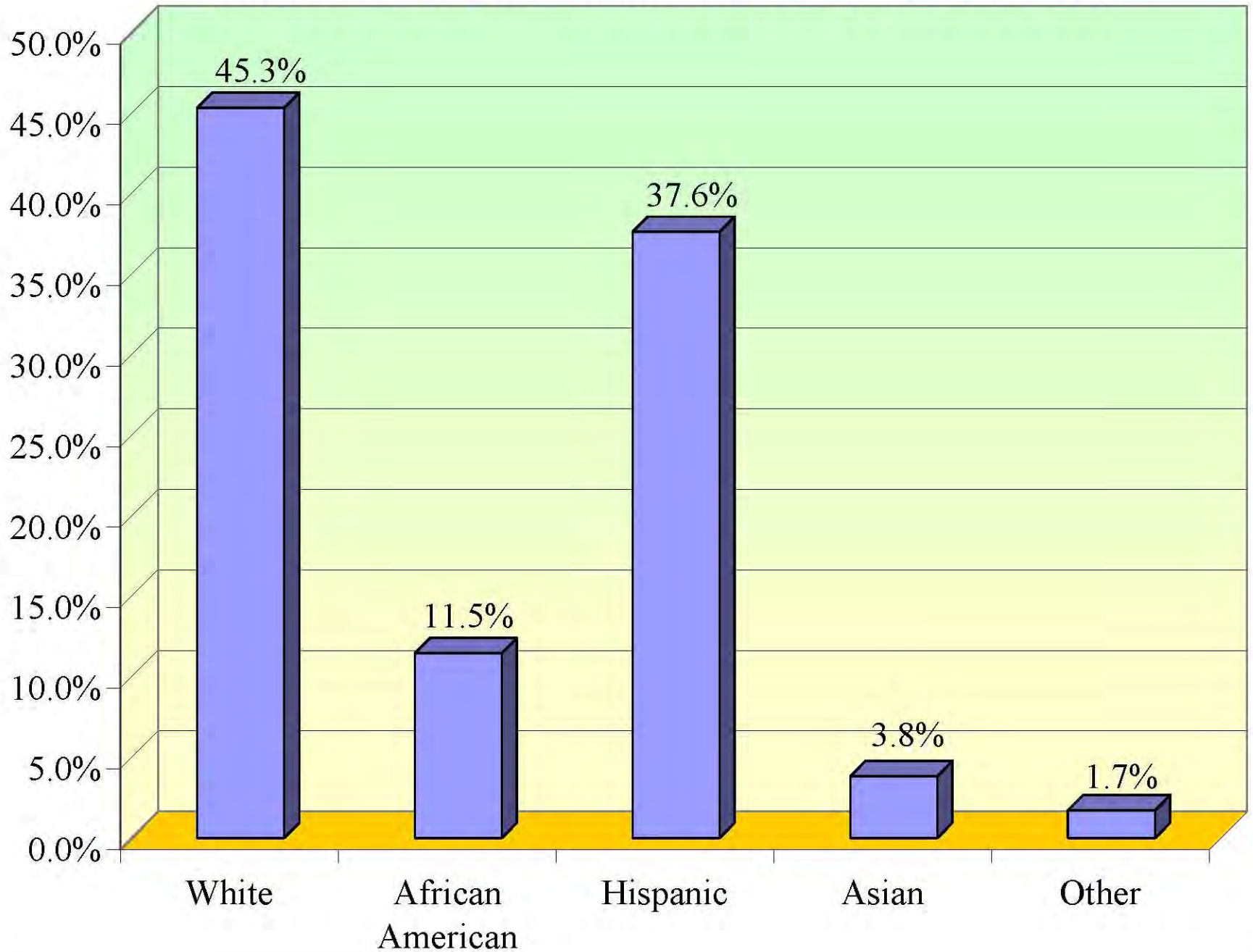

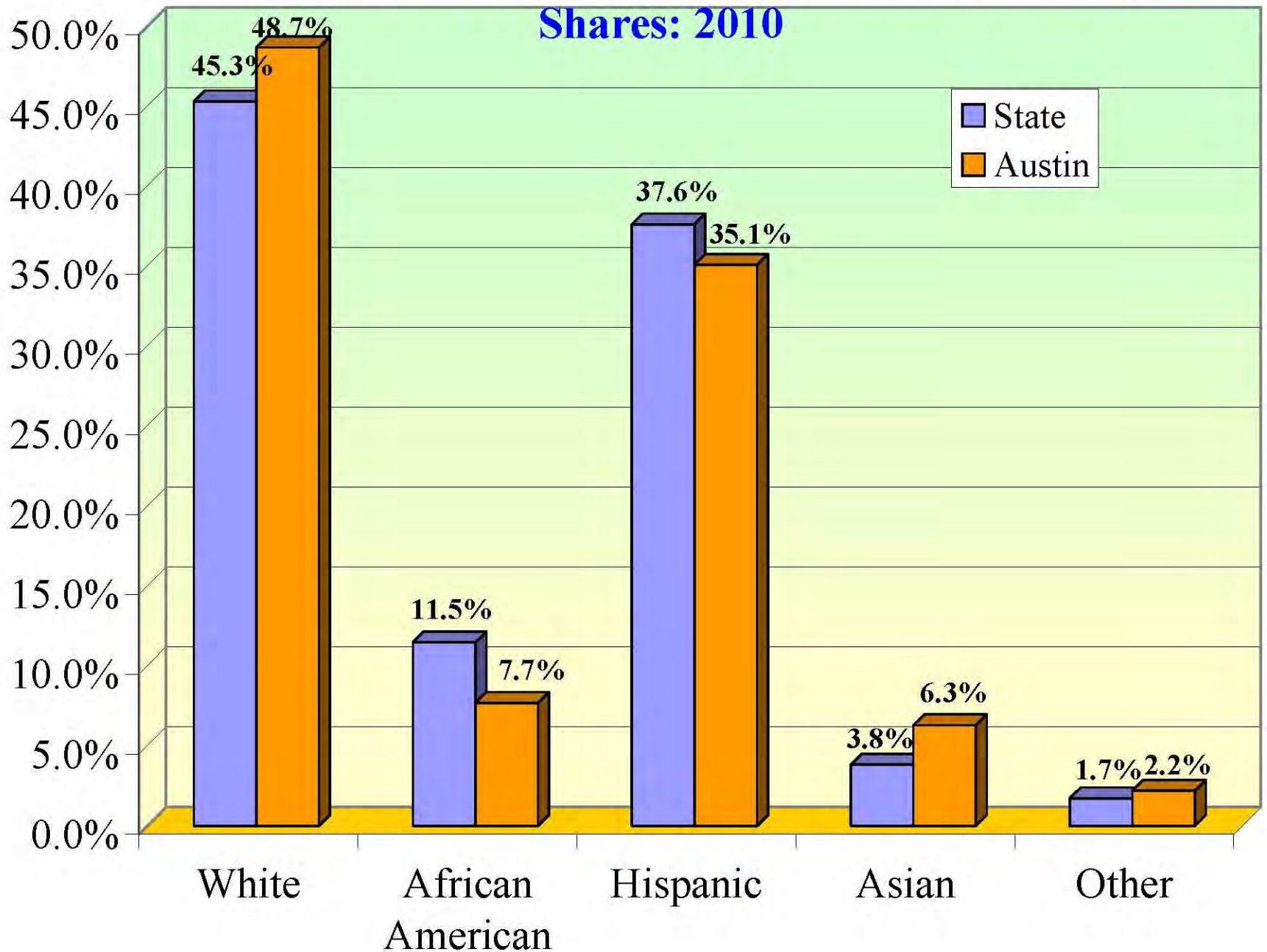


## State of Texas Racial and Ethnicity Shares: 2010



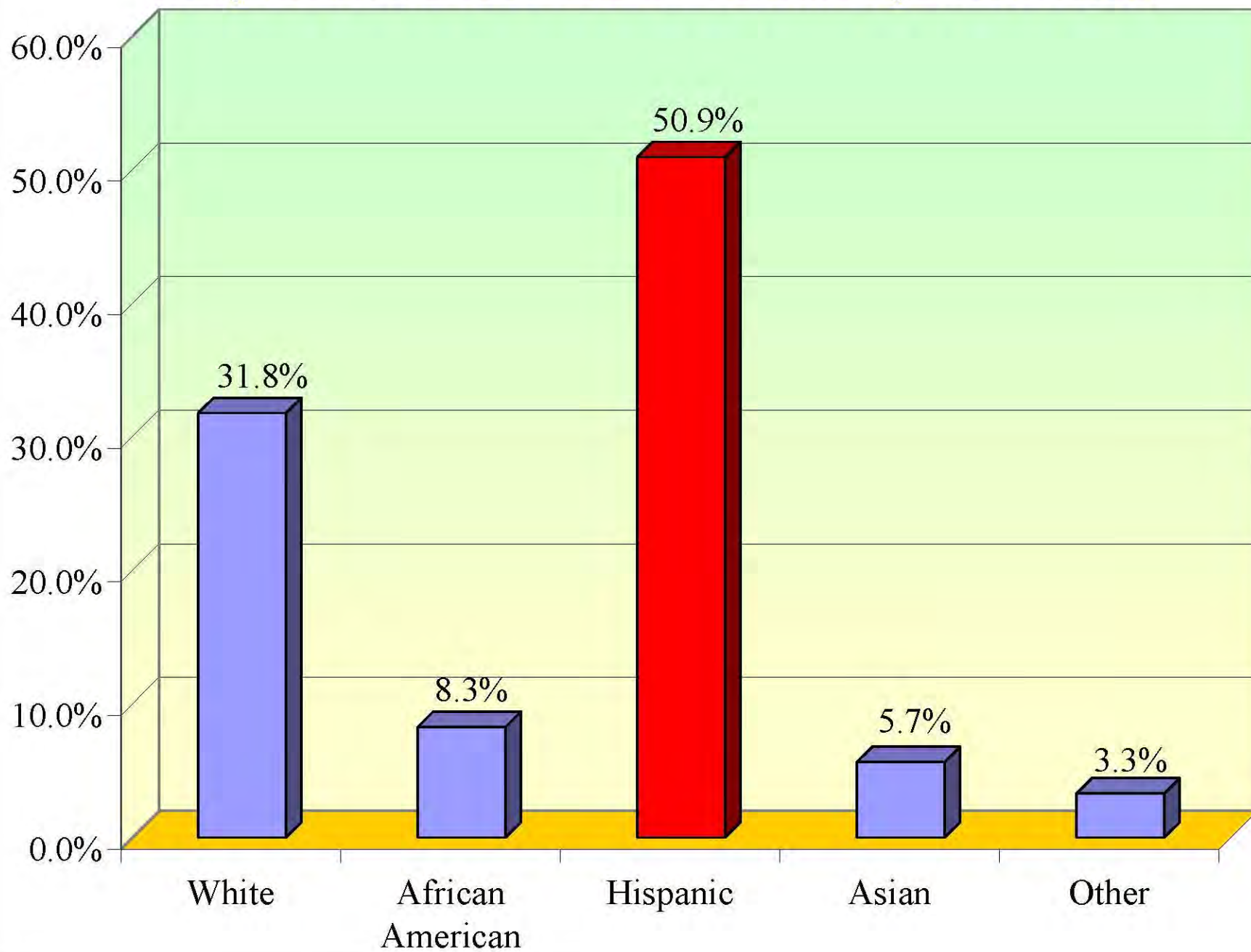

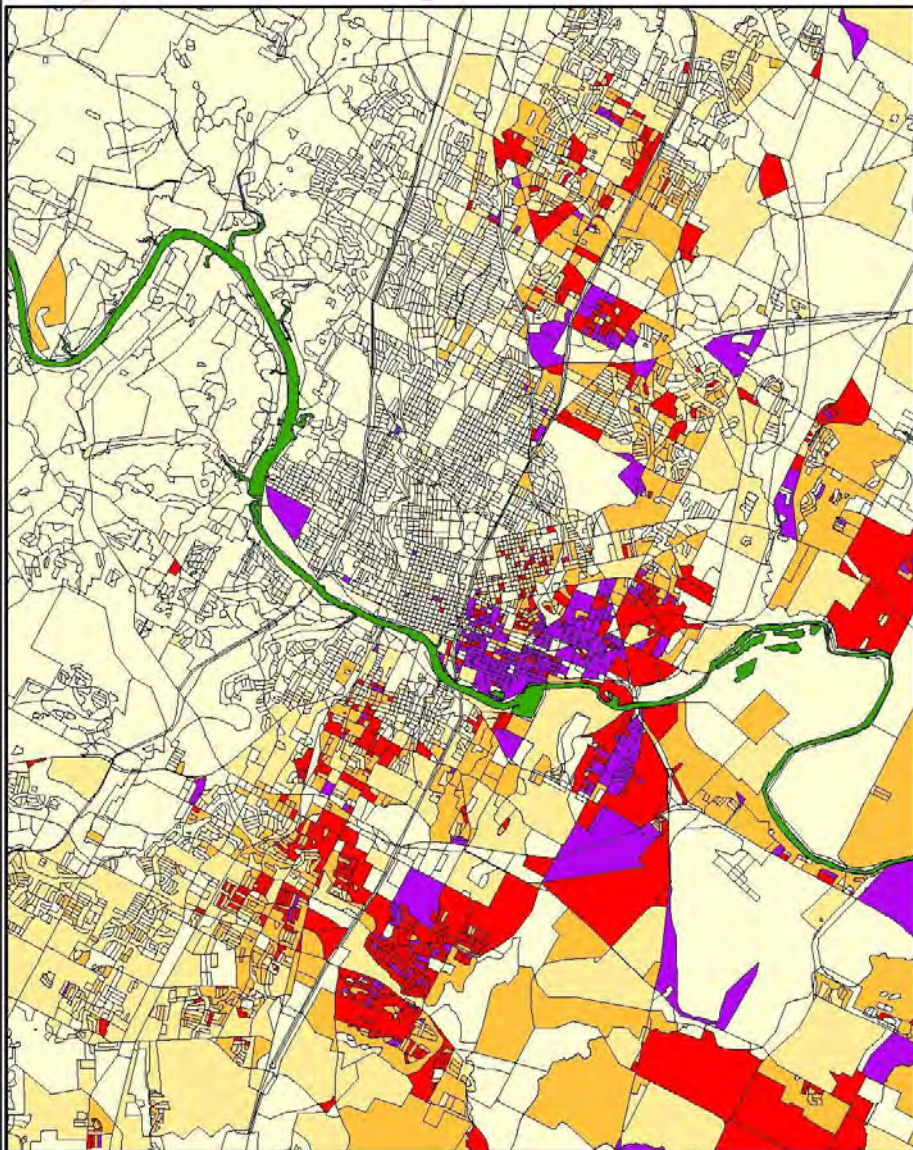

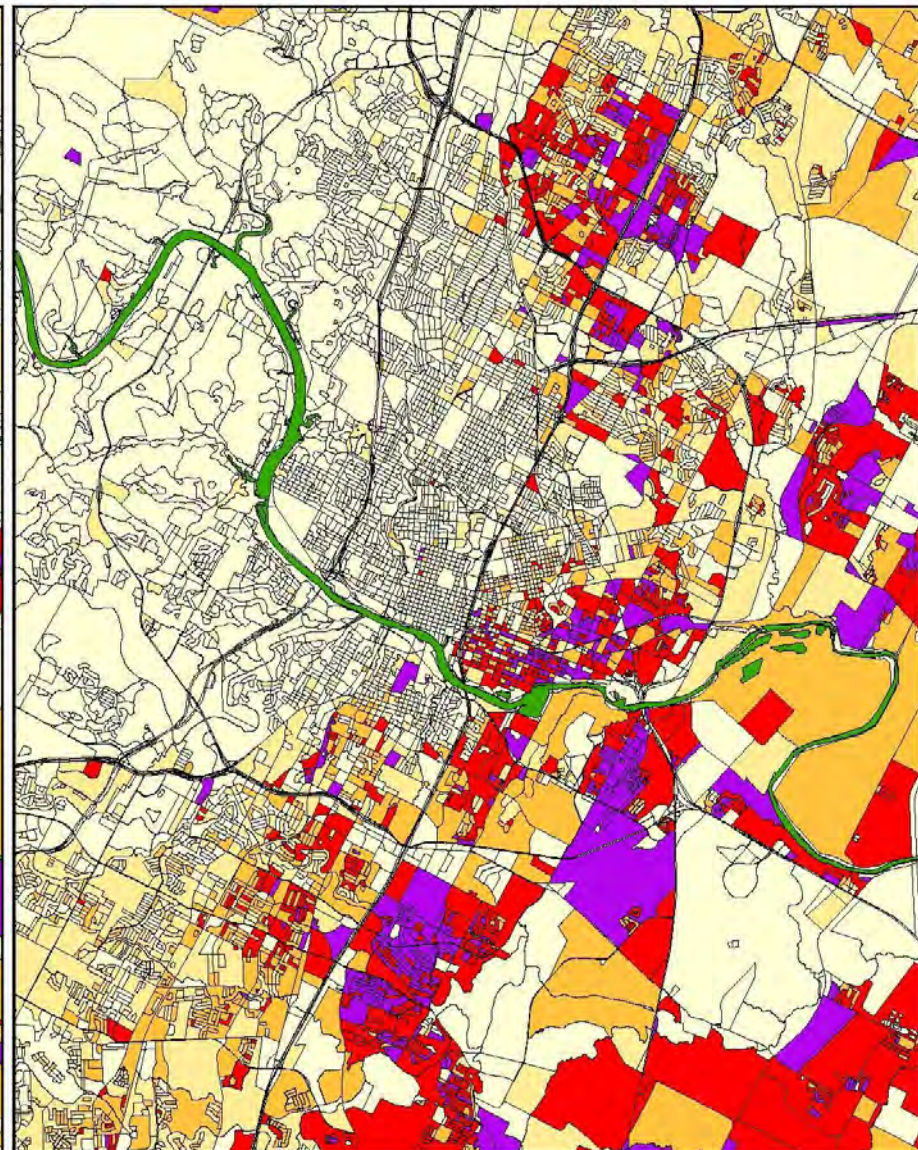

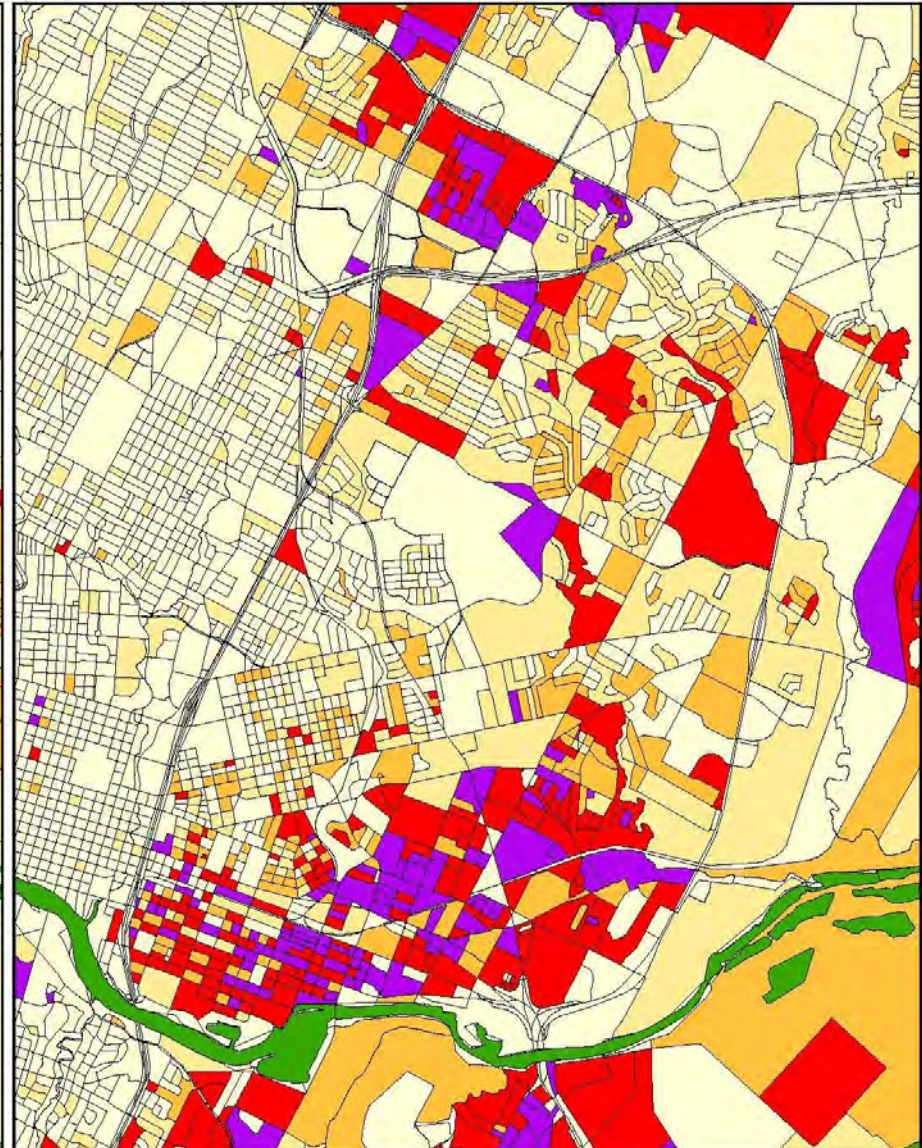

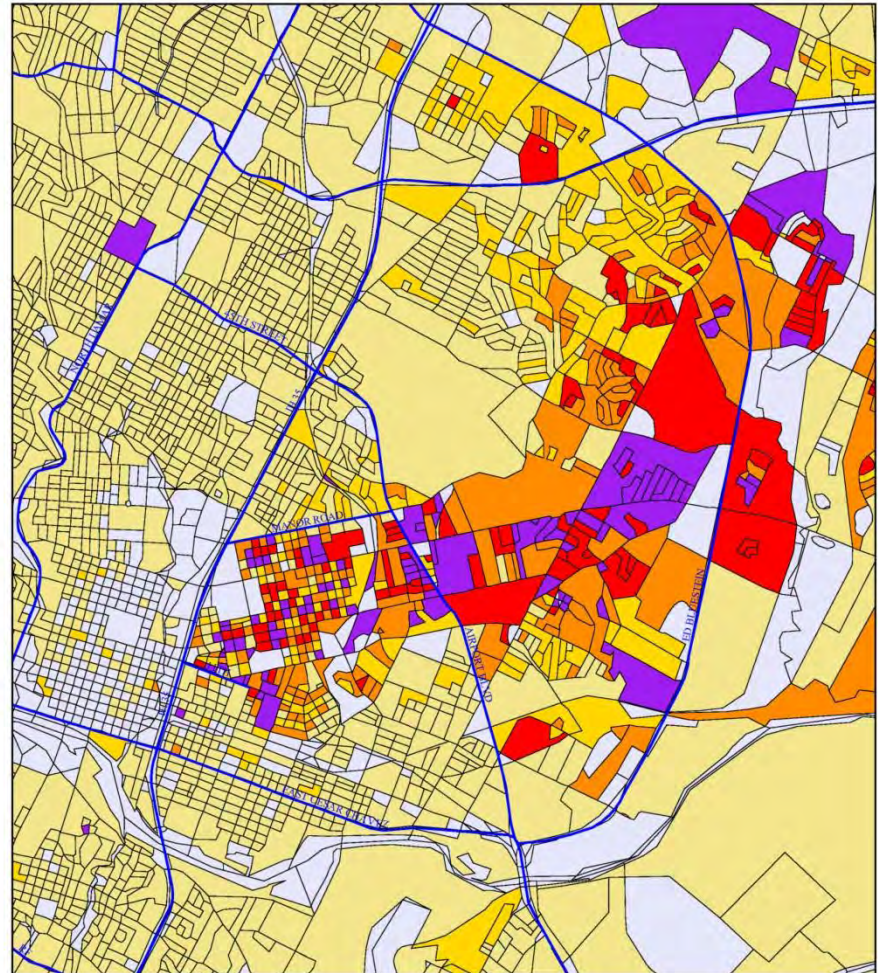
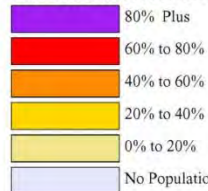
African-American Population Concentrations, 1990 and 2000.

**Change in a Census Tract's Total African American Population from 2000 to 2010 at the 2000 tract-level**



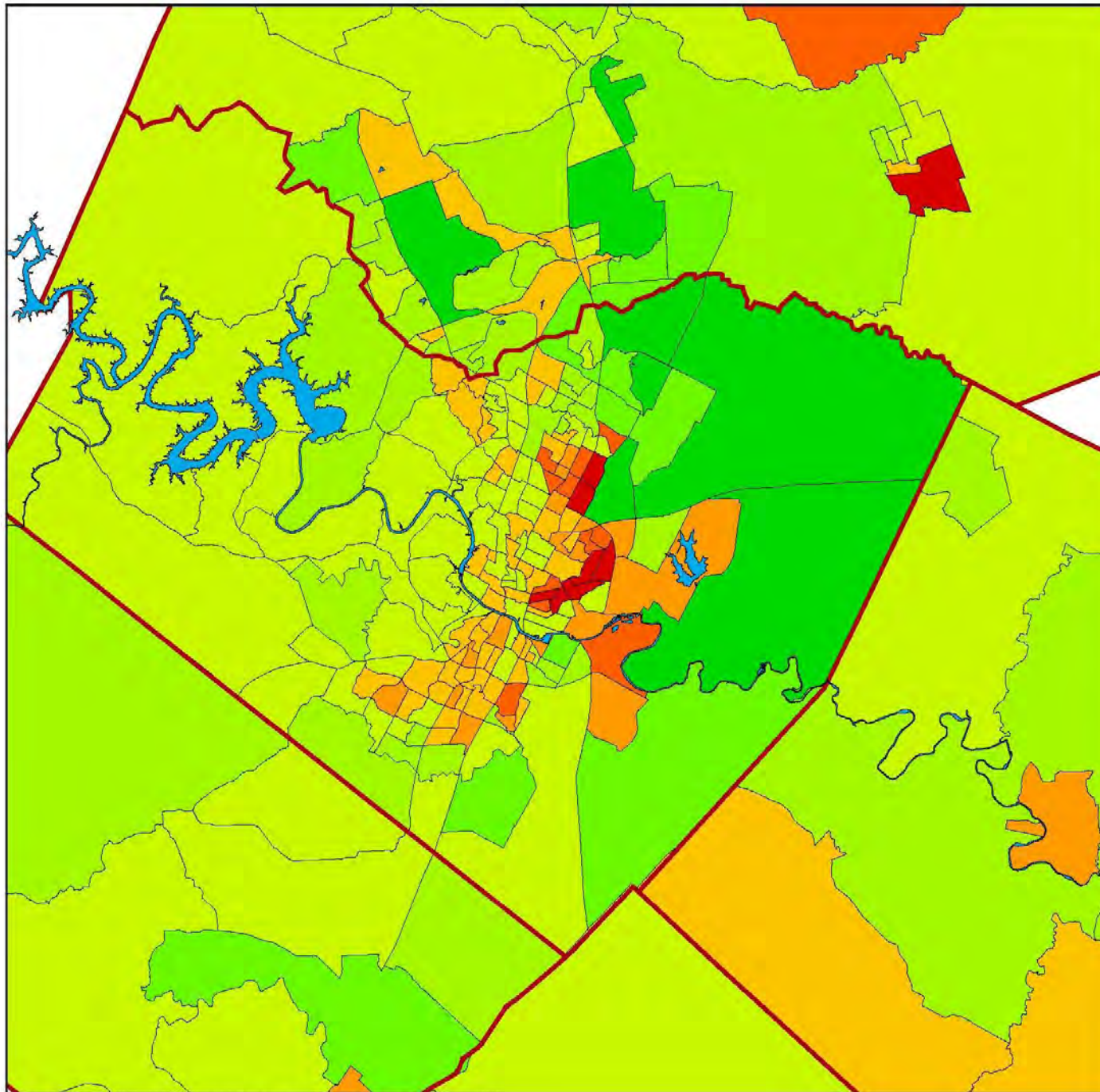
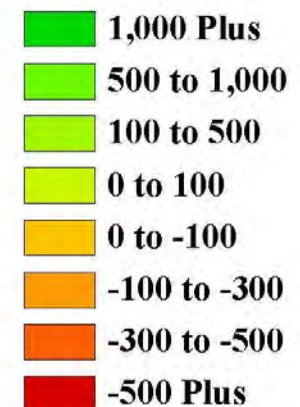

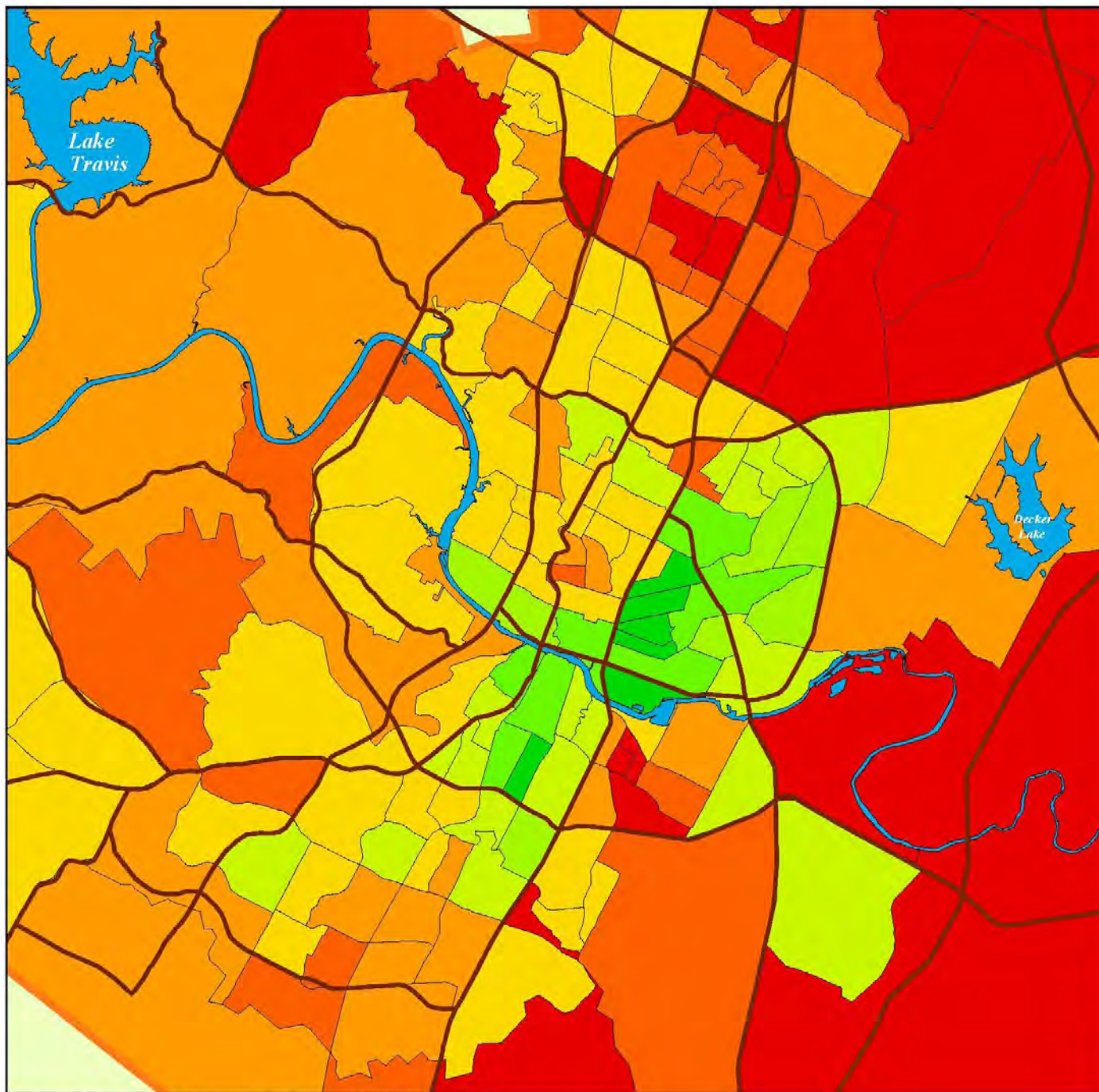

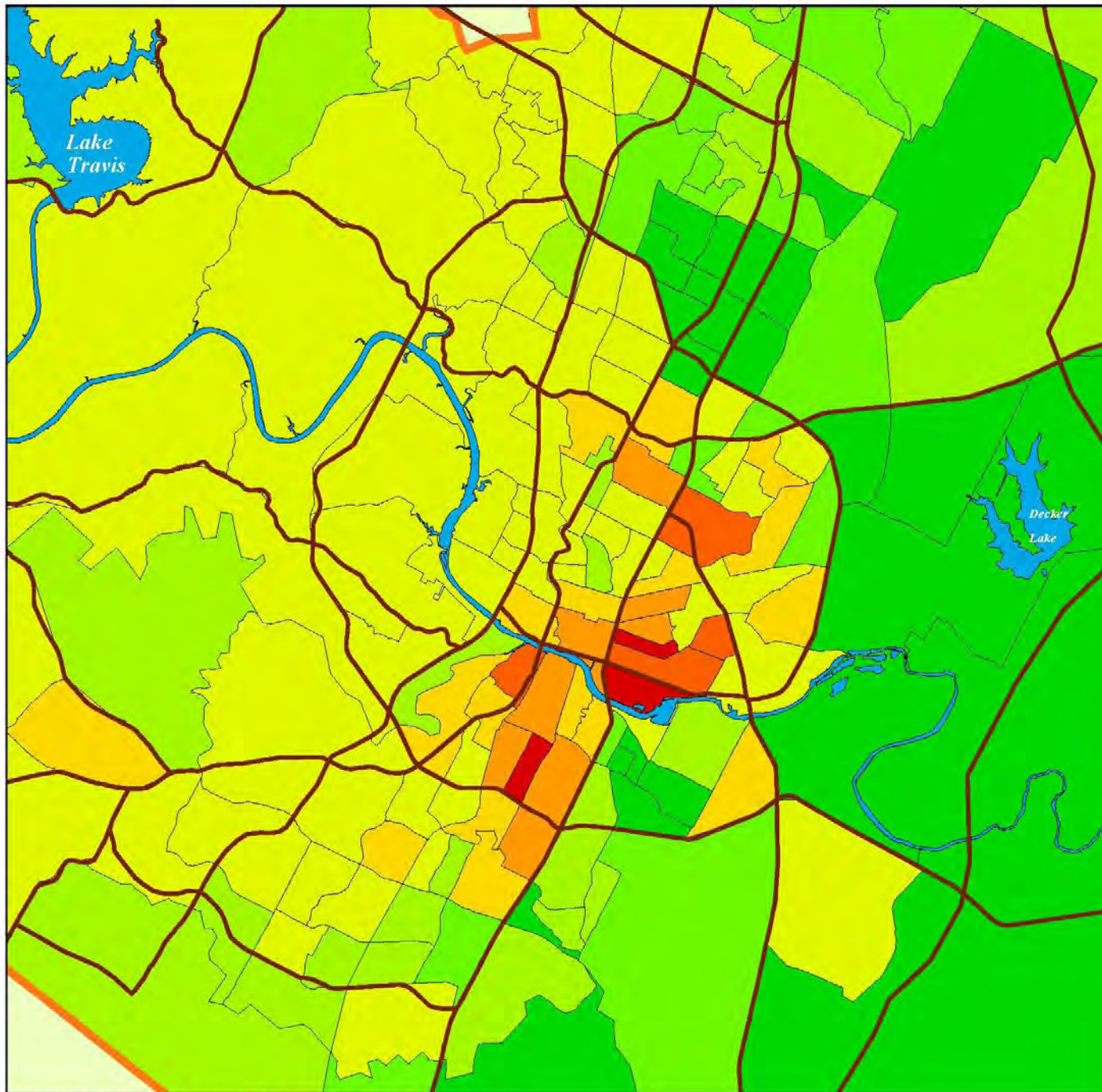

# Census 2010 Observations/Conclusions

- Much of the overall population growth for metropolitan Austin was suburban during the past decade.
- The urban core witnessed a somewhat patchy landscape of population gain and loss.
- The total population continued to diversify in terms of racial and ethnic makeup.
- One out of every two children within the City of Austin is now Hispanic.
- Decrease in total number of African Americans within the City as the overall metropolitan African American community expanded and suburbanized.
- Working-class Hispanic households continued to concentrate within Barrio-like neighborhoods while middle-class Hispanic households continued to disperse and suburbanize.
- Continued rapid growth of the Asian community with a deconcentration of household clusters across the metropolitan region.
